7th Grade Language and Literature Summer Reading ~ One-Pager Project Analysis Restart by Gordon Korman

A one-pager is a collage of illustrations and written analyses on one page that make up an aesthetically pleasing and detailed interpretation of a subject, art form, or piece of literature.

Directions: Share your unique understanding of the novel *Restart* by Gordon Korman by imaginatively blending your written ideas with colorful images from the story. Use a standard size piece of blank cardstock paper (8.5 x 11). It is recommended that you spend at least 30 minutes brainstorming and choosing your details before getting started.

Below is a list of what should be included on your page:

- Include the title of the novel and the author.
- Include three or more important quotations from the novel.
- Include four or more illustrations/graphic images (symbols, characters, events).
- Include one theme or universal message from the novel.
- Include a short description of two or more characters from the novel.
- Explain briefly the main conflict of the novel.
- You must fill the entire page.
- Your page must be colored.

Grading Rubric:

Overall Appearance	Your page is detailed and neat. Images are clear and the text is easy to read. The overall appearance is creative, colorful, and aesthetically pleasing.	20 Points
Information	Your page includes the novel title, author, theme, and character description.	20 Points
Graphics	You chose illustrations that include and/or represent important symbols or characters from the event.	20 Points
Writing Conventions	You use proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation.	20 Points
