



In 2014, the New York Times asked Steve Jobs, the founder of Apple, a simple question:

Interviewer: So, your kids must love the iPad?

Steve Jobs: THEY HAVEN'T USED IT. WE LIMIT HOW MUCH TECHNOLOGY OUR KIDS USE.



THE YONDR SOLUTION

The Yondr pouch and unlocking base allows students to experience the focus, creativity, and relief that comes from a phone-free school day.





HOW IT WORKS


POUCH

Turn off phone.
Place inside under staff supervision.




LOCK

Push the lock button and take the phone to class.



UNLOCK


Tap green ring to magnet and press button to unlock.





DAILY PROCESS

SCHOOL ENTRANCE / EXIT



ARRIVAL DEMONSTRATION

- Turn phone off or on airplane mode.
- Slide phone into pouch.
- Close the top of the pouch.
- Press the green push-pin button to secure.





DISMISSAL DEMONSTRATION

- Tap the side with the green circular ring to the unlocking base.
- As you tap the pouch on the base, push the button to release the lock.
- Retrieve your phone and close the pouch back up.
- Keep your pouch with you for the following school day.





WHAT IF YOU FORGET YOUR POUCH?

YONDR

If you forget to bring your pouch to school, your Homeroom Teacher will collect your phone and return it at the end of the day.

The cell phone policy will be enforced bell to bell each school day.



WHAT IF THE POUCH IS DAMAGED, LOST, OR STOLEN?

YONDR

If you damage your pouch, school staff will collect your damaged pouch and your phone and keep it in the front office for the remainder of the school day. If your pouch is damaged or lost, you will be responsible for an \$30replacement fee.

If you decide not to pay the fee, you cannot bring a phone to school.





WHAT IF THE POUCH IS DAMAGED, LOST, OR STOLEN?



If you deliberately damage a pouch and it can no longer be used, the following leveled responses will be used:

- First Time: Administration will meet with the parent/guardian; you will have to pay the replacement fee .
- Second Time: you will have to pay the replacement fee and 3-day suspension.
- Third Time: You lost the privilege of bringing a device to school.

POUCH CARE



Treat your pouch like any other school issued property.

Don't pull, pry or damage the pouch in any way.

Pouches will be checked <u>daily</u> in Homeroom.

Your pouch is your responsibility <u>at all times</u>.

The pouch should be **closed at all times.**
