2023 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

SCHOLARSHIPS

- The scholarship selection committee will choose the scholarship recipient.
- One scholarship will be given to at least one high school senior from each active county in the TTAA Heartland Chapter for up to \$1,000. Each scholarship is paid directly to Texas Tech University, deducted from the fee statement at one half of the scholarship amount per semester. First payment will be made for the upcoming fall semester.
- Scholarship is only for the Lubbock, Texas campus.
- Applications will be submitted by email.
- Applications and references must be emailed by: **Sunday, March 26, 2023, at midnight CST**

ELIGIBILITY

Any eligible high school senior graduating during the 2022-2023 school year that meets the following criteria:

- High School weighted GPA of 3.0 or above
- Student must be accepted and enrolling for full course load (minimum of 12 hours) for the upcoming Fall semester at Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas
- Available to any student enrolled at Texas Tech University pursuing any degree plan or major
- The student or student's parents/guardian must reside in one of the counties that actively participates in the TTAA Heartland Chapter
- All information must be completed, and applications must be signed. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

CHECK OFF LIST

1. Fill in the application completely. The application is available as a **PDF** and must be completed in the student's handwriting in blue or black ink.
2. Include high school transcript. This does not need to be an official transcript from the registrar – a copy is acceptable.
3. Include a copy of your Texas Tech University acceptance letter or picture of you holding your acceptance sign
4. Include 2 letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from a high school teacher/advisor
 - b. One from a personal recommendation, preferably from someone in the community who knows your leadership abilities or has been involved with you in an extra-curricular activity (i.e. church, volunteer organization, employer, etc.)



- c. Recommendation letters **MUST** be emailed directly to the scholarship committee at ttaaheartlandscholarship@gmail.com from the person writing the letter of recommendation
 - i. In the subject line, please include “HS Reference for *NAME OF STUDENT*”
- d. Deadline is Sunday, March 26, 2023, at midnight CST
5. Sign the application and obtain a parent/guardian signature, if under 18.
6. Email the completed application and transcript in a **PDF format** to:
 - a. ttaaheartlandscholarship@gmail.com
 - b. In subject line, please include “2023 TTA Heartland for *NAME OF STUDENT*”
7. Applications must be emailed by **Sunday, March 26, 2023, at midnight CST.**

AFTER APPLICATION IS RECEIVED:

1. An email confirmation will be sent to all applicants no later than **Monday, March 27, 2023, at 5 p.m.** to verify that application was received by the TTA Heartland Chapter Scholarship committee
 - a. If you do not hear from the committee, please reach out to us no later than **Tuesday, March 28, 2023, at midnight** to review the circumstances of the situation.
2. Complete applications will be reviewed by the scholarship selection committee. All applicants will be notified via email whether their application was selected or not by May 1, 2023.
 - a. The scholarship committee will request photos from the scholarship recipient(s) for the media release.
