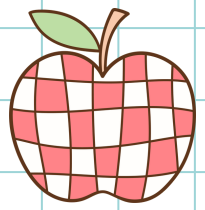

Welcome Back!

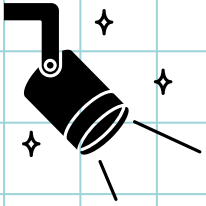

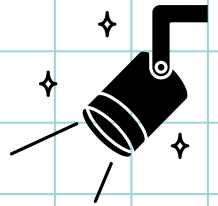

Tips to Start The School Year Off Right

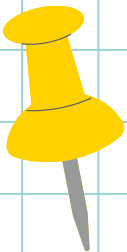
- Pack backpack and choose clothes the night before.

Please read and click on the information below:

- **Calendar**–Go on the Demarest School District website and click on County Road/Luther Lee Emerson Schools. When you scroll to the bottom you will see Upcoming Events. If you click on View All, it will show you month by month when events are taking place. Please do so to start filling in your family calendar. Dates and times are subject to change.
- **LLE Dismissal**–Please know that we will not allow students to meet whomever is picking them up on the playground. This can create a supervision concern for our staff. Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian while on the playground.
- **Lost & Found**–Be sure to label your child’s coats, sweatshirts, water bottles, lunch boxes, etc.
- **My child will be absent**
 - Press 1 to reach CRS
 - Press 2 to reach LLE
 - Then Press 2 to leave a message on the absence line
 - In the message please inform if you want to pick up homework at 3:15
 - Vacation homework requests must be made 4 school days in advance and handed in on the students first day of return
