

From the desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

Go Crusaders!

As the fall sports seasons are launching, I wanted to remind both parents and students about our policies about athletic participation and academics. I check grades regularly (at least every two weeks) and notify students, parents, coaches, and the athletic director or the appropriate faculty sponsor regarding any student who is ineligible to leave early or be absent from school to participate in or attend a school-related activity. This includes athletic events and off-campus field trips.

From pages 9-10 of the Student Handbook:

Eligibility Policy for Activities

Academic study is the primary emphasis within the Christian education program at Saxony Lutheran High School.

Participation in co-curricular activities is a privilege and is based on satisfactory class work.

Failure to meet this minimum may make the student ineligible for interscholastic competition or activity for a semester. The student has this time period to achieve passing grades and/or the required GPA.

Academic Probation

Students who do not meet the above eligibility requirements may request to be put on Academic Probation for one semester. The requirements for Academic Probation include:

The student must have passed all courses the previous semester.

The student must have earned a GPA of at least 1.75 for the previous semester.

The student and parent(s) must schedule a meeting with the principal or counselor to request Academic Probation. This meeting should take place during the first two weeks of the semester.

The student's grades will be reviewed every two weeks. The student must be passing all courses with a GPA of at least 2.00 to participate in activities for the following two weeks.

The coach or sponsor of the activity will be informed of the Academic Probation status.

Academic Probation may be used for one semester only during the high school years.

From the desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

Eligibility and Attendance

The student must be in attendance at school prior to Period 4 the day of a practice, contest, or performance in order to participate unless the activity falls on a Saturday, a holiday, or a day in which school is not in session or the activity is part of a class. Exceptions to this rule include, but are not limited to, doctor's appointments, funeral in the family, and college visits and must be approved by the principal preferably in advance.

No student will be permitted to miss instructional time for a non-academic activity if in the last grade reporting period (last two weeks) they have an average below a C- in all of their classes combined or if they have a failing grade in ANY of their classes.

Students must be in compliance with Saxony's eligibility requirements as presented and with the following MSHSAA requirements:

"A student in Grades 9-12 must have earned, the preceding semester of attendance, a minimum of 3.0 units of credit or have earned credit in 80% of the maximum allowable classes in which a student can be enrolled in the semester, whichever is greater, and shall currently be enrolled in and regularly attending courses that offer 3.0 units of credit or 80% of the maximum allowable credits which may be earned, whichever is greater, or a student must be enrolled in a full course at his or her level in a special education program for the handicapped approved by the Missouri State Department of Education which, though ungraded, enrolls pupils of equivalent age, and that student must have made standard progress for his or her level the preceding semester. A beginning 9th grade student shall have been promoted from the 8th grade to the 9th grade for first semester eligibility. A student must be making satisfactory progress toward graduation in accordance with Saxony school policy."

TESTING INFORMATION

This month, <u>ALL freshman and sophomores</u> will be taking the Pre-ACT test. Because of the size of our freshman class, we will be testing the freshman on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 16</u>, while the sophomores will test on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 18</u>. Mrs. Kiehne or Mrs. Benkendorf will be working with the students to complete registration information for these tests and scores will hopefully be ready in October for Student-led conferences if we receive them from ACT. Don't forget to get your rest and eat a nutritious breakfast on the morning of your test.

On Oct 7, we will be administering the PSAT to any sophomores and juniors interested in sitting for this test. For Junior test takers, the PSAT is a gateway to be included in scholarship opportunities including the National Merit Scholarship. The PSAT fee is \$35.00. This test is given online on student devices here at Saxony. If you did not sign-up for the PSAT on registration day but still wish to take it, please contact Mrs. Benkendorf as quickly as possible.

On October 14, we will be offering one of our 2 opportunities to take the ACT during the school day. This date is optional for any junior or senior who wishes to take the test. If you did not sign-up for the test on registration day but still wish to take the ACT in school on October 14, please contact Mrs. Benkendorf by September 15th.


<u>ASVAB</u> - If you are interested in taking the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery), please talk with Mrs. Benkendorf so that we can work with our local recruiter to make that happen. The test is normally given during 2^{nd} semester.


