School Improvement Plan
2026-2027

Goal 1: NHS will increase CCRPI score by 3% for the 2026-27 school year.

Action 1: Provide substitutes, registration, dues and fees for professional organizations, and travel funds for staff professional learning and opportunities to attend various academic conferences and trainings to help create engaging instructional strategies that promote critical thinking and improve our instructional programs.

Action 2: Allocate funds for acquiring educational tools, such as literacy resources (book vending machines, books for reading stamina/support, and summer reading packs) instructional technology (desktop scanners), and various online software platforms (including Read 180, IXL, Moby Max, Zipgrade, Progress Learning, Edulastic, NearPod, Study Island, Huddlboxes, Albert (Learning by Doing), and KUTA). This investment aims to enhance direct teaching methods and improve the overall learning experience and environment. Additionally, consider investing in a poster printer to further support instructional needs.

Action 3: Provide salaries for collaboration and professional learning off contract time, substitutes, and professional learning books to support the professional learning process and maximize student learning.

Action 4: Provide necessary daily school supplies (pens, pencils, notebook paper, copy paper, spiral notebooks, composition notebooks, etc.) as well as items for class projects (construction paper, markers, crayons, graph paper, scissors, glue, posterboard, etc.) for students in need.

Action 5: Provide technology needed to support instruction and data analytics (poster printer, mobile charging stations, audio enhancement, cold laminator, desk top scanners, IPADS, MacBooks, printers, printer ink, etc.)

Goal 2: PBIS will emerge to distinguished by the end the 2026-27 School Year.

Action 1: Invest in a Title-I funded position of Achievement Specialist to assist students with positive academic and social behaviors to improve credit acquisition and stakeholder engagement.

Action 2: Purchase and implement evidence based programs and software (Smartpass, Apptegy, Student Conductor) to support improvement in attendance and discipline.

Action 3: Attend various conferences/ trainings including funds for registration and travel to improve our ability to provide an effective positive behavior program.

Goal 3: Increase the overall growth and student achievement percentiles amongst 9th and 10th grade students on MAP assessment in reading and math.

Action 1: Invest in salary to fund an intervention teacher and necessary materials in recovery of high school credits.

Action 2: Invest in salaries and necessary materials (IPAD, laptop, snacks, and supplies for parent events) to fund a position of Family Engagement Coordinator and related expenses such as printing of instructional or family engagement materials in order to improve communication between the school and the students' families, promote parent engagement in their children's education, and to encourage greater community involvement in the school.

Action 3: Provide Saturday and after school tutoring throughout the year for students needing additional support and who have been identified academically as at-risk students.
