





Do you feel a 4 day school week has positively impacted your child academic success?




- Yes, a 4 day school week has made a positive impact on my child's academic success.

Academics aside do you feel a 4 day school week has positively impacted your child's mental/emotional well being?




- Yes, a 4 day school week has made a positive impact on my child's mental/emotional well being.

Has the switch to a 4 day school week positively impacted your family as a whole?




- Yes, the switch to a 4 day school week has positively impacted my family.

Do you feel the move to a four-day school week has positively or negatively impacted your child who receives SPED, ESL or other services?


