The Frazier School District is pleased to announce we have been notified by the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA) and were awarded \$500,000.00 in grant monies to update and replace windows and doors at the Frazier High School, as well as add updates to the Frazier High School HVAC system.

Mr. Turek, Frazier School District Superintendent of Schools said, "The Frazier School District is very blessed to have been selected as a recipient of the grant funding. The High School is in great need of both doors and windows, which will provide additional security and safety to the staff and students at the high school," Turek said.

In May of 2024, the Frazier School District applied for the **Public School Facility Improvement Grant** after contracting the services of Mr. Terry Planton, grant writer.

"Mr. Planton played a large role in the grant submission and we are thankful for his expertise," said Mr. Douglas Clingan, Frazier School District Board President. "This grant is going to make a huge impact on our district and its students," Clingan said.

The Public School Facility Improvement Grant Program was extremely competitive for the grant funds and the demand far exceeded the available monies. CFA received eligible requests of \$820.3 million for the \$175 million that was available.

"I truly appreciate the support and assistance Representative Ryan Warner played in helping to obtain the funding," said Turek. "Both Representative Warner and Senator Stafano have been extremely approachable, as well as instrumental in obtaining the Public School Facility Improvement Grant, I can't thank them enough for their assistance."

The Frazier School District looks forward to taking the next steps in the grant process, as they will be posting the Frazier HS windows, doors and HVAC out for bid, as they anticipate the project to begin in the Summer of 2025.
