The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, September 17, 2007, at 6 p.m. at the Jaycee Building.

Call to Order

Chairperson LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: P. Guthrie, G. Cook, G. Lawson, J. Johnson, and B. Coltrane. Tommy McDonald was not present for the meeting.

Moment of Silence

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance

The JROTC from Southwestern Randolph High School presented the colors and Bowman Carroll, a student from Farmer Elementary School, led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Recognition of Guests

Chairperson Williams recognized principal representatives Brian Toth and Chris Vecchione, assistant principal representative Shane Fink, and members of the press.

The student reading was presented by Mikayla Trogdon, a fifth grader at Seagrove Elementary School.

Minutes

P. Guthrie made a motion seconded by G. Cook that minutes of the meeting held on August 20 and 21, 2007, be approved as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

Public Comments

There were no public comments.

Adoption of Agenda

G. Lawson made a motion seconded by B. Coltrane that the Board adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

Consent Items

G. Lawson made a motion seconded by P. Guthrie that the Board approve consent items as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

1. Assignments and Releases – 14 releases, 27 assignments, and 4 denial(s) for student assignments for 2007-2008 school year.

- 2. Approval of Eastern Randolph High School JROTC Booster Club with one revision in Article IX of the By-Laws: Upon dissolution of the Club, all funds on hand, after payment of all legal obligations, shall be distributed to the Eastern Randolph High School JROTC program fund.
- 3. Providence Grove High School Change Orders #7 Additional foundation work for football field lights, add plastic laminate casework, install condensate drains and additional ductwork, and revise electrical panel \$19,646.80; #8 Add waterproofing to below grades walls at auditorium and add shelf angle to support brick above roof at auditorium \$20,042.17; #9 Delete WR backer board at CMU parapets, delete drains and water lines at dumpster pads, and install silt fence along Baldwin property for road widening -\$10,235.20 for a total new contract amount of \$29,146,424.03.

SAT Update

Dr. Sharon Johnson, Director of Testing and Accountability, reported that the Critical Reading Score for Randolph County for 2007 increased five points over 2006, while the average state score remained the same as the previous year, and national scores decreased by one point. The Mathematics scores for the county decreased by three points, state scores decreased four points, and national schools decreased three points. The average total score (Critical Reading, Mathematics, and Writing) was one point lower in the county than the previous year, while the state and national scores decreased by seven points. The number of SAT test takers in the county increased by 53 students. Trinity High School and Randleman High School showed the highest increased in scores. Randleman High showed increases on all sections of the SAT in comparison to last year. Eastern Randolph High School and Southwestern Randolph High School scores decreased from the previous year.

School Opening/Attendance

Superintendent Donald E. Andrews reported that the membership for the first 10 days of school was 19,142, approximately 148 more students than projected. He reported that the opening of the year had gone very well at each school and with transporting students to school. He also stated that there were less concerns or complaints than were typically received at the beginning of a new school year.

2008-2009 School Calendar

Superintendent Andrews presented a draft of the 2008-2009 school year. The calendar is very similar to the one for the current year. It will be placed on the school system web page for review and comment from the public.

Tobacco Legislation

Superintendent Andrews also presented a draft of Policy 7250 reflecting state law banning the use of tobacco and tobacco products on school campuses. The policy will be presented for approval at the November meeting of the Board.

Saturday Morning Graduations

The Superintendent also presented pros and cons for Saturday morning graduation for seniors and information on surveys taken at the high schools from students, parents, and staff. Surveys showed no definite approval or disapproval for changing graduation from the last day of school to Saturday morning. The Superintendent reported, however, that Southwestern Randolph High School had expressed an interest in piloting the Saturday morning graduation. Administrators will be discussing this pilot program and will report back to the Board.

Providence Grove High School Update

Providence Grove High School Principal Rick Dawes reported that he had met with Curriculum Specialist at the Central Office to begin establishing academic and career and technical education courses for the new school. Application has been made for a JROTC program. Work has begun to build the student database and application has been made to the High School Athletic Association.

Facility Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Director of Facilities and Construction, provided updated information and photographs of the Providence Grove High School construction site.

Marty Trotter provided pictures to update the Board on construction at Providence Grove. He reported that construction is on schedule.

Facilities and Construction Update

Mr. Trotter reported that high schools had received a special allotment to update cultural arts, science and athletic facilities.

Mr. Trotter also reported that a preconstruction meeting was held on September 11 for Wheatmore High School and the groundbreaking was held on September 16. The construction company is beginning to mobilize and set up an office on site.

Closed Session

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by P. Guthrie that the Board go into closed session to discuss the terms of an employment contract as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11 (a)(5) and to consider a personnel matter that involves an officer or employee of the board as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(6).
