Starline requires that all volunteers attend the Volunteer Training Program prior to helping in the classroom or participating in other duties throughout the school environment. The sessions are held in August, the first two weeks of school, and, as need-ed, throughout the year. When you have completed the orientation/training session, you will be issued a volunteer badge which must be worn while on the school campus.



## Are You Considering Donating to Tax Credit?

Arizona tax law allows taxpayers a tax credit of up to \$400 if they elect to support school extracurricular activities. If you choose to donate tax credit to Starline Elementary, the monies may be applied to no preference, an approved club or program, or kindergarten enrichment.
