Helpful Hints

Blends- 2 consonants that stand together and each consonant makes its sound.

- -These are the I-Blends: bl, cl, fl, ql, pl, sl
- -These are the r-blends: br, cr, dr, fr, qr, pr, tr
- -These are the s blends: sc, sk, sl, sm, sn, sp, st

Contractions are joined words that have been shortened by leaving out some letters. An apostrophe (') is used in the exact place where letters have been left out (e.g., let us = let's)
