If we choose not to have a childcare center at this time, there is a strong possibility that we will not have it because the school will not be adapted for it. LSAT is in agreement to advocate for both childcare and healthcare centers. A response has not been received.
- e. A request was sent to DCPS for a written timeline and written scopes of work.
