

## **Daily Self-Certification Before Attending Koraes Elementary School**

*Please Self-Certify your child daily by asking the following questions.*

*If any answer is “Yes”, do **NOT** send your child to school. This also **includes any siblings.***

- 1. Has your child been in close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?**
- 2. Has your child been advised to stay home/quarantine by the Health Department/Health Provider?**
- 3. Has your child or anyone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 or getting tested?**
- 4. Was your child tested for COVID-19 within the past 14 days and results are pending?**
- 5. Does your child have any of these symptoms?**
  - **Fever (100.4°F or higher) or chills**
  - **New onset of moderate to severe headache**
  - **Shortness of breath**
  - **New cough**
  - **Sore throat**
  - **Vomiting**
  - **Diarrhea**
  - **New loss of taste or smell**
  - **Fatigue from unknown cause**
  - **Muscle or body aches from unknown cause**

*If your child or anyone in the household has one or more symptoms, the child (and siblings) must stay home, the sick child self-isolates, call a physician and get tested for COVID-19. Before returning to school, the parent must provide the child’s negative molecular PCR Covid-19 test result and/or a doctor’s note with diagnosis. The parent must speak with the school office before the child returns to school. Thank you for your cooperation.*
