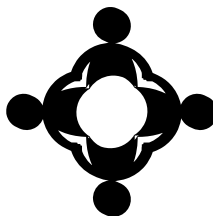


2026 Christopher Johnson “Champion in Life” Scholarship



“Impacting and Influencing Lives in the Community”

Purpose: This scholarship is given in memory of Christopher “Chris” Johnson, a Northside High School student athlete who passed away in June 2007 at the age of 17 from leukemia. The recipient will be a scholar athlete who possesses good leadership skills, serves as a positive role model, and exemplifies a commitment to academic achievement, athleticism, and humanitarianism needed to be a true “champion in life.”

Qualifications: The applicant must be a graduating senior in the Northside High School Class of 2026 with plans to attend a postsecondary institution, be actively involved in **one or more competitive sport(s)** at Northside High School and have a cumulative **GPA of 3.0** or better at the time of applying for the scholarship. Demonstrated need for financial assistance may be considered also.

Application Package: Each applicant must submit the following:

1. A **completed, signed** application form (attached).
2. **Two** letters of recommendation, **one from an athletic coach and one from a teacher.**
3. A written response to a **two-part essay question** discussing your qualifications for this scholarship **AND** your career goals, with emphasis on your capacity to impact or help others. **The response must be limited to one page in length (double-spaced).**
4. An **official transcript** issued by your school counselor.

Deadline: Completed application packages must be turned in to Ms. Varlack in the counseling office by **Friday, March 27, 2026.**

Request **TWO** letters of recommendation, one from a coach and one from a teacher who both have knowledge of your academics and leadership skills. Recommendations should be returned to you in a sealed envelope and submitted with your completed application package to Ms. Varlack in the counseling office before the **March 27, 2026** deadline.

❖ **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT:**

Request an official transcript from your school counselor. Submit your transcript with your completed application package.
