In addition, students will participate in Stations of the Cross on February 25 at 10:00 a.m. These faith-filled moments are such an important part of our school community. Please note there will be an 11:45 a.m. early dismissal on Friday, February 13, and no school on Monday, February 16, in observance of Presidents' Day.
