Each year, the scholarship is awarded to exceptional student leaders, with the intent of helping them realize their maximum potential. To apply, students must be: • A high school senior • Pell-eligible • A US citizen or permanent resident • In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)	Varies

App opens Oct. 1 Priority deadline Nov. 30 App closes April 15	Idaho LAUNCH Grant Program https://nextsteps.idaho.gov/launch	Idaho LAUNCH is a grant program that provides students a one-time opportunity to have 80% of the tuition and fees at an eligible institution covered, up to a maximum amount of \$8,000. With approximately 75 million dollars available for Idaho LAUNCH funding, it is possible for this program to offer between 9,000 and 10,000 awards per year • Graduate from an Idaho High School or equivalent • Be an Idaho resident • Be enrolled in or have applied to an in-demand career program at an eligible Idaho institution • Begin enrollment by Fall Semester after graduation, unless granted an extension • Complete a Career Pathway Plan • Review the approved list of eligible in-demand careers	80% of tuition and fees up to \$8,000
