



**The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is Monday,
December 8, and is a holy day of obligation to attend Mass.**

Mass times are: 6:00 and 8:00 a.m. and 7:15 p.m. (there is no vigil the evening before as it falls on a Sunday). This feast is the commemoration of the fact that Mary, alone of all humans, was conceived in the womb of her mother without the stain of original sin on her soul (NOT the Annunciation, when Jesus was conceived in the womb of the Blessed Virgin by the Holy Spirit.)

Come join us in celebrating this special moment in the life of Mary, kept pure as she had been chosen before the world began to be the first “Tabernacle” of our Divine Savior.
