Dear Parishioners,

As we gather this weekend, we hear of the Transfiguration, as we do every second Sunday of Lent. It is not that the transfiguration occurred around this time (instead, it is celebrated in August, as there is strong indication that it occurred during the Jewish Feast of Booths/Tabernacles.

Why would the Church insist that we hear of the transfiguration during Lent? Because we need the reminder that Jesus Christ really is more than He appears - He is the Son of God made man. His glory is veiled, and in the Transfiguration, He reveals it, even for the briefest of moments. But this vision gave the Apostles Peter, James and John something to meditate on as they entered Good Friday.

I cannot help but think that St. John meditated on the contrast of transfiguration and Christ's glory revealed and the crucifixion and how far Christ descended into the depth of sin and death by dying on the Cross. As we are preparing to stand on Calvary with our Lord, we too need to remember that Christ is the Son of God, and that the Cross is not the final word, even as Christ dies on it, but it is Christ who conquers and puts death to death. With the end in mind, we might be able to enter the conversion process of Lent, know that we will experience glory by entering in the Cross.

Last weekend, I vocally shared (despite a raspy voice) that I under-budgeted a couple of things including health insurance and heating (fuel and electricity) for the Church of St. Edward. Insurance alone was at least 30% higher than budgeted, and part of the issue was the costs went up and we have more people on our insurance than in the past. This is a good thing that we can offer insurance – it is a matter of justice that we do so. But our healthcare system is broken and the costs for insurance take the

Because of this, I really encourage us to examine our current level of giving. Some are perhaps giving at the same level they did 10 years ago, while others might be in a better position today due to having no children at home or pay raises, for example. I am aware that our economy is not good. Again, prayerfully consider what is an appropriate amount to contribute to the parish – does it speak of your trust that the Lord will provide or demonstrate your thanksgiving for what the Lord has provided? When the Lord calls us before Him, will it show that He and His Church were more important that our bank accounts?

Thank you for all who contribute so much and know that we being as frugal with your contributions as we can.

Drawing a parallel between the Hebrew people's "arduous path from slavery to freedom" and the plight of modern migrants and refugees, the Pope invites us to use this period as an opportunity to consider how we relate our own lives with the struggles of those who are forced to flee "situations of misery and violence in search of a better life" and "in this way discover what God is asking of us." This, he writes, "would be a good 'examination of conscience' for all of us wayfarers."

"It is hard to think of the Biblical exodus without also thinking of those of our brothers and sisters who in our own day are fleeing situations of misery and violence in search of a better life for themselves and their loved ones. A first call to conversion thus comes from the realization that all of us are pilgrims in this life."
