

# Minutes for School Council Election

## 1. Call to Order

Asst. Principal Kyon Cobb \_\_\_\_\_ (name) called the election to order at 5:33pm \_\_\_\_\_ (time)

## 2. Recognition of Electing Body, Roles/Responsibilities of School Council Members, Position(s) Available on School Council, School Council Election Procedures

## 3. Nomination(s) for School Council Membership

Asst. Principal Cobb \_\_\_\_\_ (name) accepted nominations until no further nominations were made by the electing body. Asst. Principal Cobb \_\_\_\_\_ (name) asked for a motion from the electing body to close nominations on these positions. The nomination to close was from M. Rangel \_\_\_\_\_. Asst. Principal Cobb \_\_\_\_\_ (name) then asked for a second motion to close, which was presented by Ms. Donna Hunter \_\_\_\_\_ (name) and a majority vote of the electing body to close nominations on this position.

## 4. Voting Procedures

Asst. Principal Cobb \_\_\_\_\_ (name) instructed the electing body on the following voting procedures:

1. The electing body will write in the position and term length on the ballot.
2. The electing body will write in the name of the nominee on the ballot for whom they wish to vote.

3. The plurality method will be used in conducting the election. One vote will be taken. The nominee with the highest number of votes is elected to the school council. Where two individuals tie with the highest number of votes, subsequent votes will be required until one single individual emerges with the highest number of votes.
4. Each member of the electing body should turn in their own completed election ballot to the election tellers for counting.

## 5. Counting of the Election Body Votes

Ms. Hunter (teller) informed the presiding officer of the number of votes each nominee received from the electing body:

1. Dallas Hardy (nominee name) 6 (number of votes)
2. Krystle Freeman (nominee name) 6 (number of votes)
