I wanted to thank the teachers for their involvement in the WASC survey conducted Monday. We received data from all PLC's and have begun to assemble this data into a comprehensive report. This was the first step in retrieving information for this April's mid-year review. The plan is to condense the data into a report draft then ask the staff again for revisions. After speaking with the WASC Commissioner we feel confident we are on the right track and will be ready for this spring's review. Kudos for getting the ball rolling with Monday's data collection.

Message from Administration:

Earlier this week we were given a chance to further practice our emergency evacuation procedures when an alarm went off unexpectedly in one of our restrooms. Though an unfortunate interruption, it has proven to be a fortunate event because it exposed some areas in our emergency plan where we needed further communication. So to clarify, in future such events, at the first sound of the fire alarm we do NOT immediately evacuate our classrooms but rather remain in the classroom until further notice. The time needed for confirmation may take a few minutes, so please be patient and keep your students in the classroom.

If we confirm the event is indeed a fire, the message will come across the intercom as "It has been confirmed there is a fire on our campus. Please evacuate to your designated area in the football stadium." At that point teachers will escort their students to the stadium.

If the event is confirmed to not be a real fire, the message will come across the intercom as “It has been determined that the fire alarm is a false alarm, please remain in your classrooms and continue instruction”. At this point the event is over and instruction can resume.

If, as happened Wednesday, the event extends from a class period to a passing period, lunch, or break, students should stay in class until the confirmation message to evacuate (or not) is given.

We are scheduling an ALICE Intruder on Campus drill in the next weeks that will further improve our preparedness.

There is nothing more important than our ability as a campus to respond to an emergency. I appreciate the cooperation during the recent drills and hope this week’s false alarm can be used as an additional opportunity to improve our emergency procedures. Thank you and have a good week.
