

Non-Resident Student Enrollment for Children

Category: O of Staff Members Policy – Pittsburg School District

For the purposes of this Policy, non-resident staff is defined as staff who work for the Pittsburg School District and do not reside in Pittsburg or Clarksville (based on their area agreement). If space is available (Grades PK-12), non-resident staff may apply for their children to attend Pittsburg school without paying tuition subject to the following requirements:

1. Non-resident staff must submit a request to the Pittsburg School Board prior to the start of the school year.
2. The School Board shall only approve attendance for one school year. The non-resident parent must reapply to the Pittsburg School Board prior to the start of each school year if they wish to return.
3. Non-resident staff must be employed by the Pittsburg School District throughout the time that their children are enrolled in Pittsburg schools. If the parent, for any reason, is no longer employed by the Pittsburg School District, the board will determine whether the student will continue to be enrolled on a case by case basis. If a student remains enrolled in the school after termination of employment without board permission, the parent will be responsible to pay for the tuition costs out of pocket.
4. The parents are responsible for all transportation.
5. For special education students with a legal residence in New Hampshire, the district of residence shall be responsible for all special education costs as provided in RSA 193:3, IV and RSA 186-C:13, IV. Parents will notify the district of residence immediately upon applying for acceptance at Pittsburg School District, and the district of residence shall acknowledge its responsibility and agree to pay special education costs before the student is enrolled.
6. For special education students whose legal residence is not in New Hampshire, the district of residence shall agree, in writing, to reimburse Pittsburg School District for all special education costs before the student is enrolled. It is the responsibility of the parents to obtain this agreement from the district of residence.
7. The student will be subject to the same rules and discipline process as other students attending Pittsburg school. NHIAA rules apply concerning athletic and co-curricular participation.
