both parties, the agreement may be renewed for four (4) additional one (1)
year periods, for a total term of five (5) years.

Service Length
1.37 The contractual term of this contract will be one (1) year(s) with options to

renew up to a total of four (4) years.

Also Item 1 and Item 2 as it related to Item 1:

The district currently has an on-site hardware-based Barracuda device and is transitioning to a cloud-based solution. The results of this RFP/Bid will result in an award to one vendor for a single and comprehensive solution. If no single solution sufficiently meets cost-effectiveness, accessibility, integration, and ease of use, a winning RFP/Bid may not be awarded.
