  - Mid-Quarter Progress Reports
  - Quarterly Report Cards
4. **Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:**
  - Staff will be available for scheduled conferences and parent phone calls during daily planning periods and at mutually agreed upon times either before or after school.

  - Participate in school field trips;
  - Under the guidance of the classroom teacher, share specific skills/talents with their child's class including, if applicable, leading Career Awareness activities; and
  - Participate in Statewide Parenting Day with specific focus on gaining knowledge of research-based instructional strategies to replicate at home.
6. **Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand, as follows:**
  - Utilize TransAct translations offered through MCPSS;
  - Utilize MCPSS translators to assist with verbal/written communications with parents as needed; and
  - Provide translations of parent bulletins/notices, to the extent practicable, in a language that parents can understand.

**Parent Responsibilities**

**We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:**

- *Be responsible for my child's daily attendance and punctuality;*
- *Make sure that homework is completed;*
- *Monitor the amount and content of screentime interaction while encouraging positive extracurricular activities;*

- *Stay actively involved in my child's learning process by, when possible, volunteering in the classroom or serving on advisory groups, such as parent advisory committees and parental involvement groups.*
