Ants and Aphids Work Together Vocabulary

- * The children do not need to know how to spell these words. They must be able to read the word and the definition for their assessment on Thursday.
- 1. symbiosis: the close, and often helpful, association of two living beings that are not alike
- 2. scurry: to go or move in a hurry
- 3. <u>liquid</u>: a form of matter that is not a solid or a gas
- 4. partner: a person who joins or shares with another
- 5. shelter: something that covers or protects
- 6. relationship: a connection between two or more things
- 7. <u>honeydew</u>: a sweet substance secreted on leaves and stems by aphids and certain other plantsucking insects
- 8. predators: an animal, such as a wolf, lion, or hawk, that lives by preying on other animals
- 9. colony: a group of animals or plants of the same kind that live together
- 10. team: a group that plays, acts, or works together
