Notes to Enumerators

- 1. Section 5659 as amended in 1911 governs the taking of the school census.
- 2. Enumerators shall not include in the census the names of any child or children in reformatories or prisons, nor the names of any child or children in asylums, almshouses, or other charitable institutions, except as follows:
  - (a) Children in such institutions who regularly attend the public schools.
  - (b) Orphans whose parents at the time of their death resided in such school institution as located, except children in class (a) where the parents, or either of them, reside in such city or district and in such town the legal residence of the child is that of the parent.
  - (c) Children of either class shall be included in the district or ward where such institution is located, except children in class (a) where the parents, or either of them, reside in such city or district and in such town the legal residence of the child is that of the parent.
- 3. Domestic, half boys, and other persons if entitled to be included in the census, must be recorded at the residence of their parents or legal guardians. Indian children shall not be included in any census unless they attend the public schools, or their parents are liable to taxes in city or district.
- 4. The ages of children must be given as they were on May 31, 1920. If a child removes from the district during the twenty days preceding June 1, he must be recorded in the district in which he is resident May 31, 1920.
- 5. Failure to take a house to house canvass invalidates the census, and lays the district liable to loss its primary money for the year. If possible arrange names in alphabetical order.
