

Booster Meeting Minutes

5/3/2022

- Meeting began at 6:44 pm
- Minutes from the 12/20/2021 & 1/3/2022 meetings were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes was made by April Brown and seconded by Christie Danner and passed unanimously.
- A financial report was given showing a balance of \$19,625.49 in the account as of the end of April. A motion to approve the financial report was made by April and seconded by Christie and approved unanimously.
- An item of old business was briefly discussed regarding the football programs and ad sales. It was noted that April Brown would get with the officers to quote the production and printing of the programs to discuss at the next meeting. Ad sales needed to be ready to begin by the next meeting in order to capitalize on lead time and to make sure ads are ready in time to have printing done before the first game of the season.
- Coach Moore presented a request for funding for shirts to be handed out on May 19th during fourth block at an all-sports ceremony in the gym. One shirt per athlete is included in this request. The amount of the request was \$1,526.40. April made a motion to approve this request and a second was made by Christie. The motion passed unanimously.
- Coach Moore presented a request for funds for Spring sports in the following amounts: Track \$500, Baseball \$1,500, Softball \$1,500, for a total of \$3,500. A motion was made by Christie to approve this request and seconded by April. The motion passed unanimously.
- Fundraising ideas were discussed. Among these were selling apparel (hats, shirts, etc.), a draw-down money fundraiser, selling yard signs with the new sports program motto/slogan on them, pheasant hunt, deer hunt, a raffle, and the football program ads & banner sales. It was noted that with the more members the boosters organization was able to bring on-board the more fundraising opportunities would be available. Coach Moore added that he would provide an opportunity for the sports boosters to share with the parents at the All-Sport Ceremony on May 19th about the work of the boosters and provide an opportunity for parents to sign up.
- Kayla McLendon presented a request as a non-agenda item to file tax form 1023 for tax exempt status as this form had not previously been filed. It was estimated that the fee for filing this form for tax exemption would be \$2,500 and was necessary for the tax-exempt status and operation of the sports boosters as a non-profit fundraising organization. A motion to approve this request was made by April and seconded by Christie. The motion passed unanimously.
- The first meeting of GHS Sports Boosters for the 2022-2023 sports season was set for June 14, 2022 at 6:30 pm.
- A motion to adjourn was made by April and seconded by Christie and the meeting at 7:31 pm.
