Emerald of Memories

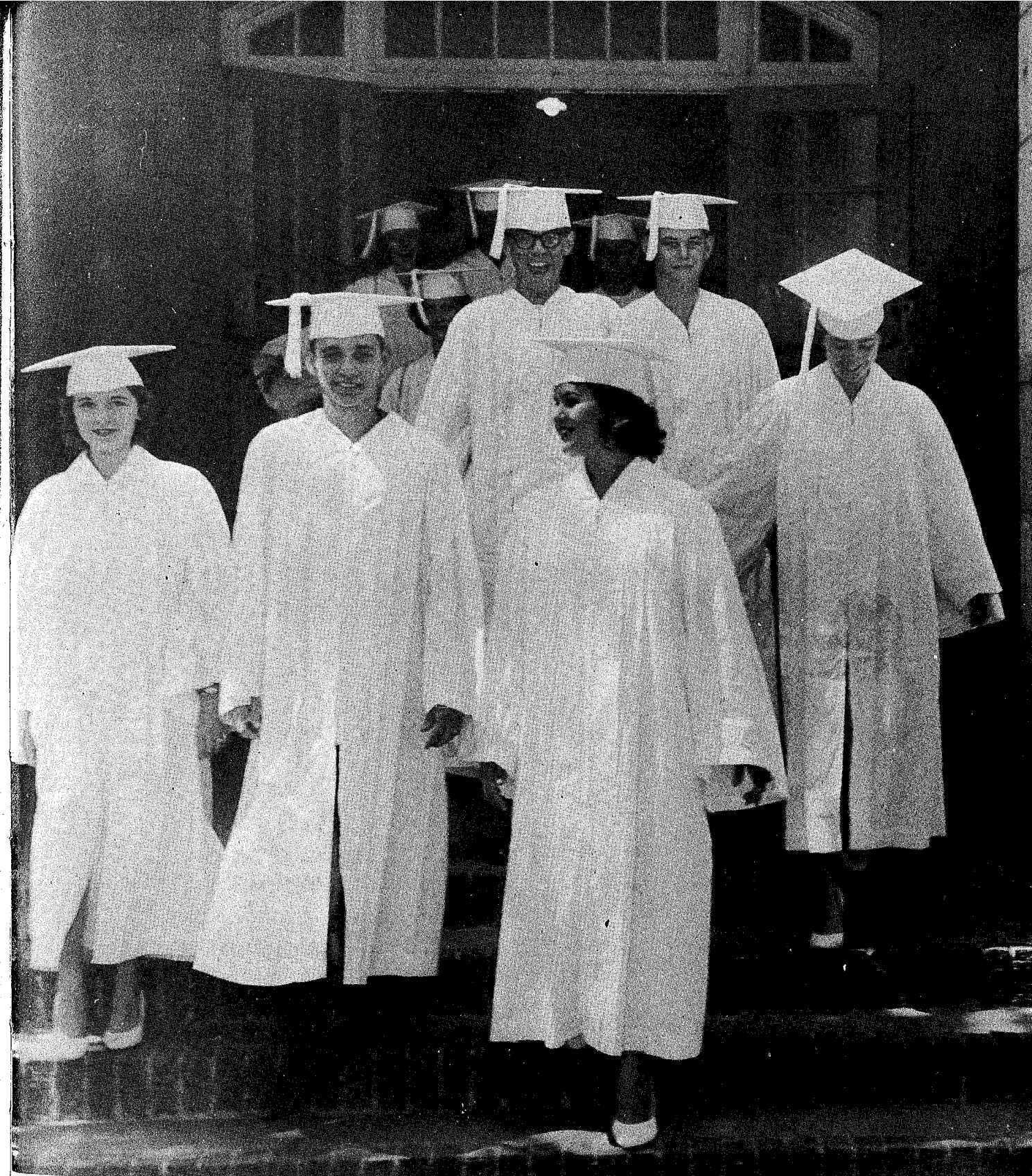


Another class has passed through the halls of Lake Wales High School and only the memories remain. The future, our tomorrow, has already become our today.
