Return to Instruction Plan: Prevention & Mitigation Strategies

Temperature checks will be conducted for students and staff with Covid-19 symptoms. Anyone with a temperature exceeding the DPH recommended temperature (100.4) will be sent home.

Wearing of face coverings will be encouraged on the school bus and in the school building. Individuals diagnosed with Covid-19 will wear a mask for 5 days upon returning to campus

Visitors allowed access to the school building will be limited during times of high transmission rates Potentially limiting attendance to large gatherings/events and/or field trips based on current status of pandemic, location, and potential for exposure.

Students with disabilities will be provided with appropriate accommodations and education for the plan based on their individual needs. Guidelines for handwashing, wearing face covering, and other COVID-19 preventative strategies will be posted around the school.

Students will be educated on how to properly wear face coverings.

Seating charts will be created for whole groups and small group instruction during times of high transmission rates.

School buses will be disinfected after each route and deep cleaned weekly.

Lunchroom, media center, gymnasium, and other gathering spaces will be cleaned after each use. Classrooms will be cleaned once daily and wiped down between groups of students.

Deep cleaning will take place weekly.

Contact tracing will be conducted to identify individuals possibly exposed to positive cases.

Testing/Screening will be coordinated with regional sites.

The administration of vaccinations are coordinated with the local health department.
