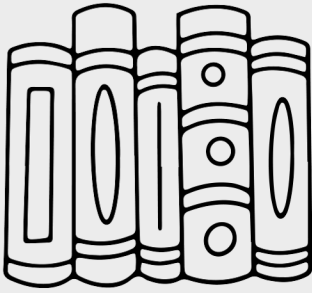

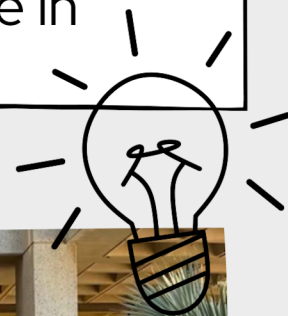

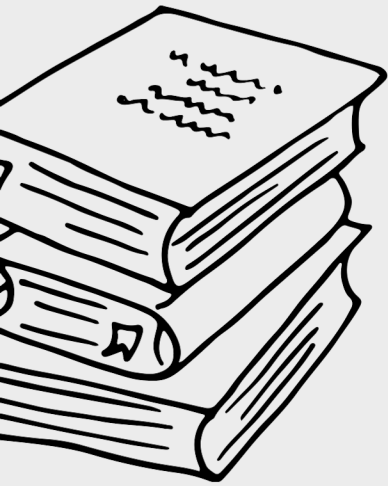

Our library was a busy place last semester!

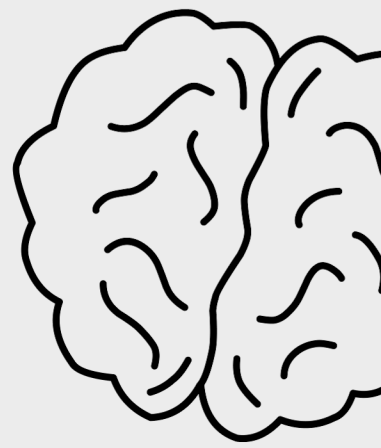
5278+ student visits
