4. <u>Course Description</u>: The 6th grade Math curriculum prepares students for more advanced courses in math. This course emphasizes reasoning, problem solving, communication skills, number relationships and theory, patterns and functions, and algebraic concepts. This course will allow highly motivated students to make a smooth transition into Pre-Algebra in 7th grade.

5. <u>Method of Instruction</u>: The consumable textbook (McGraw Hill Math) and lecture will be the primary source of information. Worksheets and homework will

be used as reinforcement. Oral communication and participation in class will be necessary. Students are encouraged to bring an electronic device so they can access and learn to use their Google Classroom accounts while at school. This is extremely important because all students will be required to use Google Classroom throughout the school year. This will prepare them in case we have to switch to distance learning.

6. <u>Attendance</u>: Good attendance and class participation are a must in order to succeed in this course. It is each student's responsibility to find out what assignments are missed during an absence and to make plans with your teacher on how to complete those assignments in a timely fashion (including tests, quizzes, and homework).
