I. Deposit

I am submitting a \$150 ***non-refundable/non-transferable*** deposit to secure a seat on the Senior Trip to Florida. I understand that if I am not able to participate for ***any reason***, I will forfeit this money after February 1, 2023..

II. Money Due

Final Payment of \$200 due March 1

*The first 45 students to sign up (with initial deposit) will be accepted on the trip. After 45, students will be placed on a wait-list. If we have enough for a 2nd bus, students on the waitlist will be notified by Jan 4 and are expected to make their first payment at that time.

Failure to maintain this payment schedule may result in your seat being sold to another student.

After February 1st, **NO REFUNDS** will be given as all money collected will be sent to the tour company.

After this date, we can only transfer/sell the spot to another student of the same gender.

III. Rules

1. Students must have a ***clean disciplinary record*** and be in good standing as approved by Skyline High School administration to participate in the Senior Trip.
2. All regular school rules apply during the trip (see student handbook).
3. Students are responsible for all missed school work during the trip.
4. No alcoholic beverages allowed at any time.
5. No smoking/tobacco products/drugs of any kind allowed.
6. No student co-ed rooms for any reason.
7. Curfew will be 11:30 pm and rooms will be checked and monitored.

IV. Permission and Behavior Agreement

Parent: I give my permission for the above student to travel to Orlando, Florida, and participate in all the events listed on the agenda. I have completed the travel form on the back of this permission form.

Student/Parent: We have read the rules for the senior trip to Orlando, Florida. We understand that at any time during the trip if the student does not abide by the rules, ***they may be sent home at our own expense***, and we will receive **no** refund. Additionally, the student may not be allowed to participate in any of the other senior events that will be taking place for the remainder of the year (i.e. lock-in, prom, graduation, etc.).

Senior Trip Student/Parent Contract

Participation in the Senior Trip is a privilege. In order to be eligible to participate, seniors must meet the following requirements:

- The senior must be **“on track” to graduate** in May 2023
- The senior must have **at least a 90% attendance rate for the 2022-2023 school year** at the time of the trip (this means **no more than 15 absences** (excused or unexcused))
- Any matters of discipline could cause a senior to forfeit their spot on the trip, even if the money has already been paid. This is at the discretion of the school administration.

Students who are found to be ineligible by administration for the senior trip will not receive a refund unless his/her reservation can be sold to another senior. It should be noted that the travel agency does not refund the school when students drop out of the trip.

There will be multiple fundraising opportunities to help pay for the trip. If a student is not able to participate in the trip but has raised funds using an SHS-sponsored fundraising event (Krispy Kreme, popcorn companies, etc), the money raised during those fundraisers with outside parties cannot be refunded to the student. Our school must sign agreements with these businesses that the money raised will be used for the sole purpose of the trip. Any outside donations/contributions need to be made to students/ family and then students are to make payment to the school.

This trip has been fully approved by Skyline High School and is subject to all school policies and regulations pertaining to school-sponsored trips and student behavior. It is expected that the seniors going to Florida will have a good time. On the other hand, for the welfare of everyone concerned, certain conduct must be insisted upon.

By signing this contract, I agree to follow all school rules outlined in the Warren County and Skyline High School Code of Conduct and acknowledge that I understand the following:

- Students will be required to cooperate with chaperones at all times during the trip.
- Smoking/use of tobacco products is not permitted at any time.
- The purchase, possession, and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages and non-prescription drugs is prohibited for all students. Such behavior will be deemed extremely serious and will result in the student being sent home at the parents' expense. All prescription and non-prescription medication must be registered and noted on the Medical Release Form (on the back of the permission slip).
- The taking of items, no matter how small the intrinsic value, for souvenirs or other purposes is strictly prohibited. In addition, local law enforcement and/or authorities at the theme parks will have you arrested if you are caught shoplifting and you will be prosecuted under Florida law. They will not treat this lightly. Anyone caught shoplifting will be dealt with by the authorities and parents will be notified.
- All students must attend all planned activities. Students are not allowed to stay at the hotel or skip certain activities. This is for the safety of the students.
- Students are to respect the property of other students, chaperones, charter buses, and the hotel.
- Curfew will be announced each evening. Rooms will be checked by chaperones at curfew and periodically thereafter, if necessary. Students are to remain in their own rooms after curfew until the following morning. Occupants in rooms bear joint responsibility for the care of the rooms, conduct of visitors, and the presence of alcohol, drugs, or other illicit items.
- Room and bus assignments are final. There will be no changing of rooms or buses unless they are made by chaperones.

- Mutual respect and group cooperation are essential for a successful trip. Students are expected to be on time for all activities.

I understand that failure to comply with school rules as outlined in the Code of Conduct or this contract may invoke serious consequences that may include, but are not limited to: in/out of school suspension, prohibition from all extracurricular and athletic activities, including Prom and Graduation. In the case of illegal activity, law enforcement will be informed.

***Failure to follow the regulations for the trip will result in that student being sent home. If it is necessary for a student to be sent home, the parents will be notified and will be responsible for all expenses and transportation costs incurred.**
