#### STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICKUP

To ensure the safety of ALIS students: <u>Student Drop-off</u>-Please travel north along Edwards Street and stop along the sidewalk in front of the building. Children should exit from the right side of the vehicle when possible. Students should not be dropped off to walk across Edwards streets. If drivers need additional time to unbuckle students or help them with something, we ask that you park past the front doors to help prevent traffic congestion.

**Student Pick-up** –ALIS has 3 pick-up spots to help with congestion. If drivers need additional time to buckle their students or help them with something, we ask that once your student is in the vehicle that you pull up past the front doors, staying in front of the school, and park to help prevent traffic congestion.
