Public Comments

County Manager Richard Wells presented information on the ¼ cent sales tax referendum which would increase sales tax from 6.75 to 7 percent. The state allows counties to levy a ¼ cent sales tax to recover sales tax revenue lost as a result of Medicaid costs passed from the state to individual counties. This increase would result in \$2.5 million per year to be used to provide adequate school buildings and address infrastructure needs in the county. Upon recommendation by Becky Coltrane, the Board of Education voted unanimously for a resolution in support of the ¼ cent sales tax.

Dr. Sharon Johnson, Director of Accountability and Testing, presented information on End of Course comparison data from the Fall of 2005 through 2008.

Drop Out Report

Sherri Trotter, Director of SIMS and Student Services, reported the dropout rate for the school system had increased over the past few years. Approximately 344 students on the average drop out of school each year. The dropout rate for 2006-2007 is 5.24%. She reported the following had been implemented to address dropouts: Hiring dropout prevention specialists, surveys to find out reasons for dropping out, formulate plans to address reasons in surveys, hire additional social workers to help address family concerns and attendance, and credit recovery through NovaNet. The top reasons for dropping out were: 51% attendance/excessive absences, 17.7% other, 13.6% community college, 10.6% moved or school status unknown, and 7.1% academic problems.

Wheatmore High School Mascot/School Colors

Superintendent Donald Andrews recommended that the Board approve the mascot and colors for Wheatmore High School as selected by Wheatmore committee. B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by P. Guthrie that the mascot be named Warriors and colors Red and White for Wheatmore High School. The motion carried: 7-0.

Presentation of 2008-2009 Budget and Scheduling of Public Hearing on Budget

Finance Officer Todd Lowe presented the 2008-2009 Preliminary Budget. The Current Expense request is \$2,071,902.00, a 12.86% increase over 2007-2008. The Capital Outlay Budget request is \$2,721,000.00, a 38.62% increase over 2007-2008.

Report on Providence Grove

Principal Rick Dawes reported that Danny Martin had been selected as Athletic Director and Todd Shuping as Head Football Coach for Providence Grove High School. The Band Boosters will meet on April 7 at Northeastern Randolph Middle School. He reported that he had talked with four vendors regarding office furniture. He hopes to make a decision on Assistant Principal next week. Teachers have received their assignments for the upcoming school year.

Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Director of Facilities and Construction, reported that construction is going well at Providence Grove High School. At Wheatmore, steel is going up. There will be a delay until August 2009 for Wheatmore School opening due to the amount of rock encountered during construction. Closed Session
