1. **Call to Order:** Pam Hilliard called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
 - A. **Members Present:** Pam Hilliard, Kendra Holden, Daniel Moyer, Wendy Fredrickson
 - B. **Administrators Present:** Supt Klaire Vogt; HS Principal, Aaron Dail; Theresa Priebe, Clerk

Adopt Agenda: By unanimous consent, the agenda was approved.
2. **Public Comments:** Josh Cruz, Hannah NeuGriffin, Jamie Rovey, and Les Wright stood before the Board of Trustees to express their support for a wrestling program at Troy.
