

8th Grade Crossover Ceremony

Guidelines for proper attire

DRESS CODE: The Promotion Ceremony is a special event; therefore, proper dress is required.

Boys

- All boys must wear dress pants. No shorts, jeans, sweatpants or cargo-like pants.
- All boys must wear a shirt with a collar. No polos or t-shirts.
- All boys must wear dress shoes with socks. No tennis shoes, flip-flops or sandals.

Girls

- All girls must wear dresses, skirts and blouses, or dress pants with blouses. No capris or shorts (including Bermudas) will be allowed.
- All dresses and skirts must be NO shorter than three inches above the knee. No exceptions.
- No single-shoulder dresses are allowed.
- No backless or strapless, tight-fitting silhouettes, low necklines, or bare midriff dresses, and NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS
- No bare midriff tops will be allowed.
- All girls should wear dress shoes. No flip flops or extremely high-heeled shoes.
- All tops/dresses should be modest and cover well. There should be no viewable cleavage.

Note: If you are unsure if your dress will be acceptable, you must bring it to the school and have it checked by an administrator prior to the ceremony. Students whose attire is not acceptable may not be allowed to participate and may be required to have a parent come pick them up.
