A. Superintendent report: Dr. Joseph Hattrick

- July 22, 2021, ODE released an updated Ready School Safe Learners Resilancy Framework for the school year
- Governor Kate Brown issued statewide mask mandate directing school districts to require enforcement of indoor wearing of face masks
- I sent out a letter to community via Facebook, website and it was covered by The Daily News and The Clatskanie Chief
- Number 1 goal for this year is to get students in school, full time. That has not changed
- Today started our 2nd week of Summer School, it is going great, approx. 120 students, earning credits at a fast pace
- 1st day of Kinder camp, 24 Kindergarteners
- Pool is on pause, would like to look at a plan for opening for swim lessons but major repairs are needed, vacuum is not working.
- ODE approved 10 Passenger Vans, we are not able to do this as manufacturers can't get them to us in time
- Agenda for the Board Retreat for the next 3 Mondays, snacks and meals will be provided

Discussion: Do we know what pool repairs are? We need to look into a dehumidifier, there is a small leak. The water level continues to go down, not substantial but we do need to pinpoint what is going on. Cost estimate for that? No, this has all been in the last few weeks. With the update on vans, is there a way we can get them expedited? Unfortunately, no.

What are our plans if our government says we have to go to virtual? This is not something we have planned for or are prepared for. We have been planning for inperson and that is the only thing we are promoting. We can still have options for those that are reticent to return in-person.

B. OAR 333-019-1015: Mask Mandate

B. Results from Ethics Committee

B. District Sports Fees

- Dr. Hattrick: Fees have fluctuated over the years
- Average athletic fees collected \$33,698.20 and the average cost has been \$164,186.11 with an average of \$125,500 transferred from our general fund
- Presented multiple options from changes in athletic fees to eliminating them.
 - Option 1 Keep Athletic Fees \$150/\$100
 - Option 2- Eliminate all athletic fees
 - Option 3 Modify athletic fees
 - 3a. \$100 per sport for H.S, \$50 per sport in Jr. High with family cap of \$500
 - 3b. \$100 for 1st sport/child H.S., \$50 for 2nd sport/child and be beyond H.S, \$50 for 1st child/spot Jr. High, \$25 for 2nd sport/child Jr. High

Option 4 – Add a provision to allow scholarships based on financial need. Application to include completion of free and reduced-price lunch application.

Questions: Is there any grant money or ESSER funds that could help offset the sports fee cost? Some funding is restricted and must be strictly related to the pandemic. For awareness, our General Fund is meant for general operations of the district, educating children. We need to consider where the additional \$30,000 is going to come from is we waive all fees.

Admission fees, sports fees go into the athletic fund. Concessions is different for groups. Purchase Services and Dues and Fees, this used to be referees and their cost. Can individual sports and expenses be tracked? Football, wrestling, cross-country and all of the sports. Graden Blue may have broken that out already, however this would not be a true cost unless we were able to combine the ASB accounts as well. Do we have a definition for senior citizen for Resolution 1. Could we create revenue by increasing admission, season passes to help offset dropping sports fees? Teams fundraise to purchase equipment. We waived fees last year, money came from general fund, but participation was much lower.

An article was read.

Suggestion of \$50 per student Jr. High and H.S with a cap of \$350, however we should look at our academic clubs and do something for them as well. As of now we have an adopted budget with \$135,000 being transferred from gen fund to athletics for this year Can we postpone this until next meeting? We can review and change as needed

Mrs. Richardson motioned to adopt option 3b and option 4 as presented, Seconded by Mrs. Usher

Discussion: Can we revisit the budget. Understand the cost for H.S. with travel etc...

Mrs. Richardson amended her motion to approve eliminating all athletic fees for Jr. High, while modifying H.S. fees to\$100 for the 1st sport/child and \$50 for the 2nd sport/child and beyond and adding scholarships based on financial need to include completion of Free/reduced-price lunch application and re-evaluating during the budget cycle, seconded by Mrs. Usher

Discussion: Now what happens? So now looking at roughly \$10,000 for Jr. High sports fees. No need to reconvene budget committee as this is within the limit. We don't want to rely on our reserves.
