Purpose of Pageant

This pageant is a fundraiser for the LL:DAWGS - the local group supporting our military families. The monies collected will be utilized to fund events for our military families, sponsor students with a deployed parent, and provide for our students as needs arise.

Entry Fee

The entry fee for the formal dress pageant is **\$100.00**. Contestants may pay personally or obtain sponsorships. The contestant with the most sponsorship money, over \$100.00, in each division will receive a trophy. Once submitted, entry fee is nonrefundable.

All contestants will be entered in the following categories: Beauty Competition, Prettiest Smile, Prettiest Hair, and Prettiest Dress.

Something NEW - Miss LL:DAWGS!!

Miss LL:DAWGS is a separate title, and will be a casual pageant. Contestants can enter independently of the Miss Lanier County pageant for **\$80.00** or one can enter in addition to the dress pageant for **\$50.00**. Contestants will wear a red shirt of their choice and jeans. Contestants are encouraged to, but not required to embellish the jeans to show the patriotic spirit. Patriotic jewelry, hair accessories, and shoes are allowed to show support for the red, white, and blue. All contestants will be entered in the following categories: Most Patriotic, Best Smile, Best Hair, and Miss LL:DAWGS. If the contestant wins Most Patriotic - an additional crown will be awarded. Upbeat music will be played to encourage a fun and lighthearted walk of choice.

Eligibility for All Portions of the Pageant

Contestants must be enrolled in and maintain a good standing of conduct, both academically and behaviorally, in Lanier County Schools. Out of school suspension will result in dismissal from the pageant. Contestants may not be nor have been married, pregnant, or convicted of a crime. There is no discrimination due to race, creed, religion, or national origin.

Judging

The pageant judges will be from out of town and will be fair and unbiased in their judging. In the event of a tie, contestants will be brought back on stage for judges to break the tie.

Prizes

Each division will have a Queen, 1st, and 2nd runner up. Queens will receive a crown, banner, trophy, and flowers. Runners-up will receive a trophy. Additional category winners will receive a trophy, and all contestants will receive a participation trophy and a crown.

People's Choice

Miss Lanier County People's Choice will also be awarded during the pageant for each division. The contestant, in each division, with the most monetary votes will receive a crown and banner. Collection envelopes for each contestant will be provided. If any additional sponsorship money is collected, add it to the People's Choice envelopes the day of the pageant.

Pageant Meeting & Practice Tuesday, May 6th, 2025 at 5:30pm

The meeting and practice will take place in the Lanier County High School Auditorium - representatives will be available for questions and for stage directions.

Pageant Day

Doors will open at 12:00 pm on **Saturday, May 10th**, for contestants. Contestants can use this time for extra practice; however, all contestants must be off stage by 1:30 pm. No men will be allowed in the contestant dressing areas.

Photographer

Money is to be paid in full to the picture company the night of the pageant. All queens and her court are to remain for group photos upon the conclusion of the pageant.

Entry Deadline

The entry deadline is **Friday, April 25, 2025**. All applications and sponsorship money are due at this time. Paperwork and fees should be submitted to the Lanier County High School office, care of Breanna Poulin.

General Admission

Admission for all will be \$5.00. Children five and under will be admitted free of charge. Doors will open to the public at 1:30 pm.
