There are 3 academic pathways for grade 6-12 students at Ridgeview Global Studies Academy:

- Traditional
- Honors
- Scholar

All 3 pathways meet the minimum State of Florida graduation and promotion requirements and lead to a standard high school diploma and college/career readiness. The Scholar pathway provides accelerated coursework through Dual Enrollment and/or AP courses with the opportunity to earn college credit.

Through a partnership with Polk State College and College Board, Ridgeview Global Studies Academy is able to offer multiple Dual Enrollment (DE) and Advanced Placement (AP) courses to students on the Scholar pathway. Successful completion of these courses and any corresponding AP exams can

 lead to college credit. Please note: issuance of college credit and transfer of college credit is determined by each postsecondary institution (i.e. college/university).Per Polk State College's Catalog/Handbook, the AA degree requires a General Education component of 36 credit hours plus 24 other credit hours, for a total of 60 credits. Pursuant to Florida Statute Section 1007.25(3) and SBE Rule 6A.14.0303, students must complete 6 credit hours in Communications, 6 credit hours in Mathematics, 9 credit hours in Humanities, 6 credit hours in Social Sciences, 9 credit hours in Natural Sciences, and 24 other elective credit hours. Additionally, students pursuing an AA must demonstrate Foreign Language proficiency, which can be satisfied by completion of two years of high school instruction in the same foreign language. It is possible to fulfill these requirements through RGSA's Scholar program.
