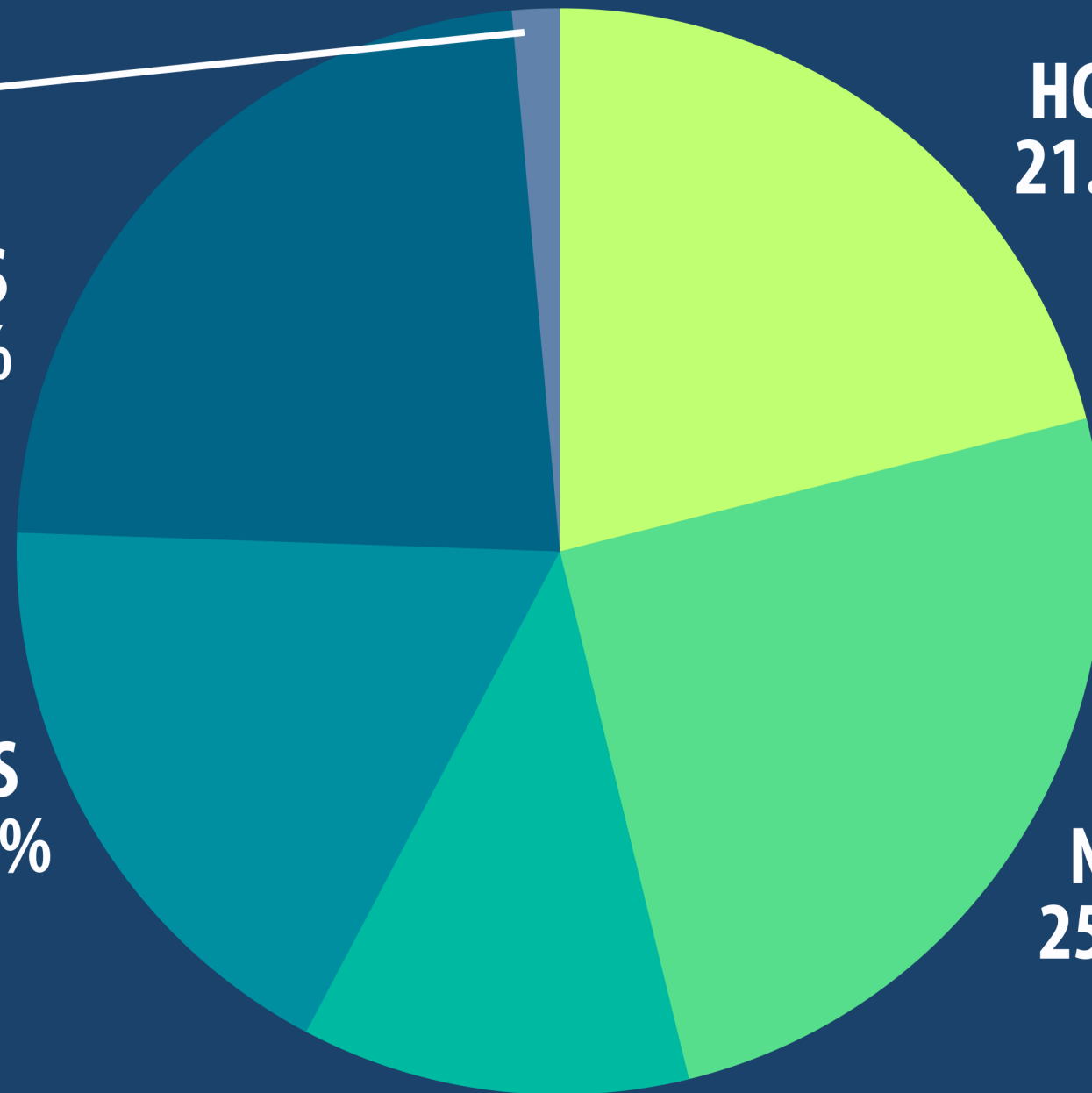

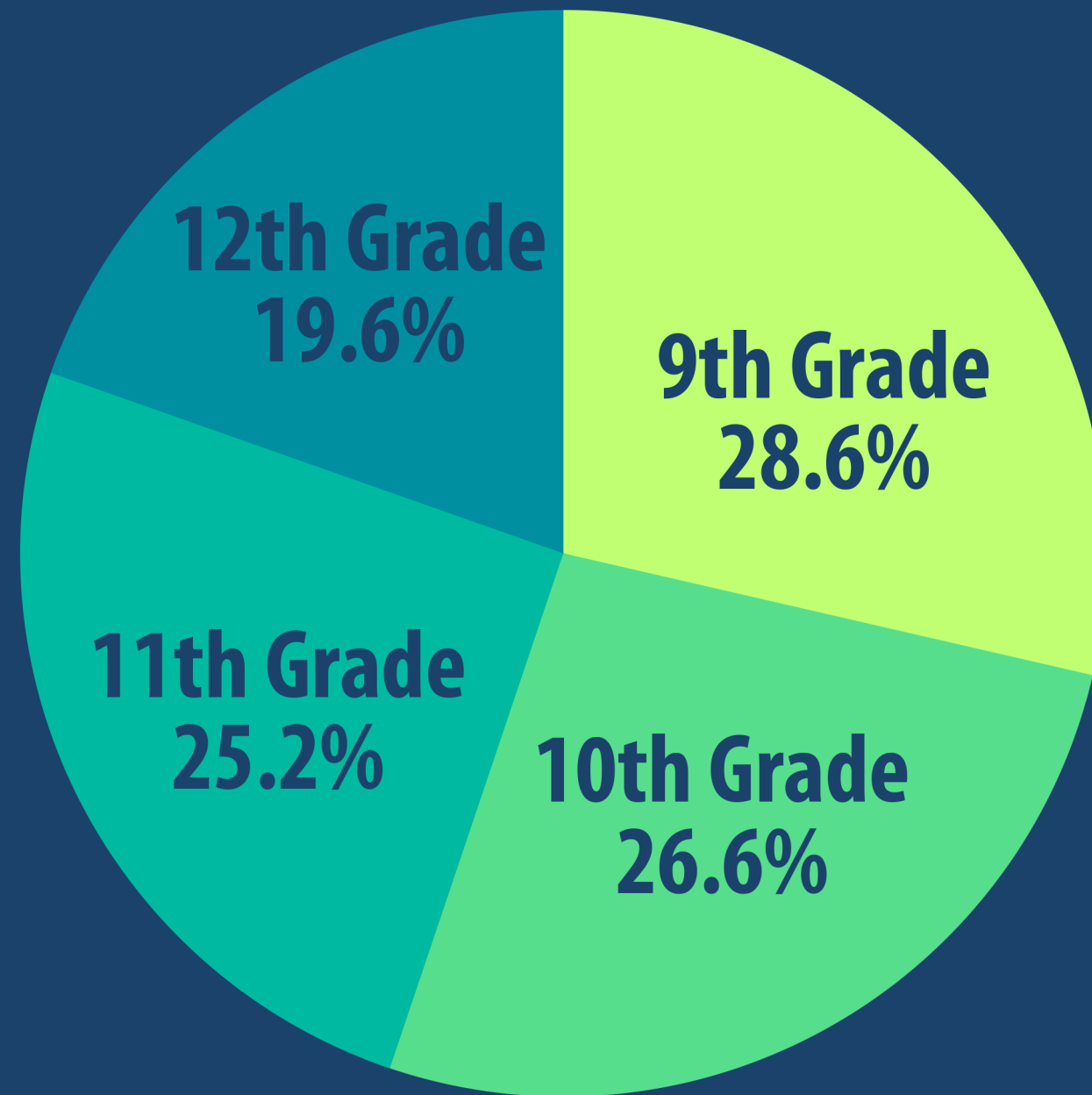

10. Resume Writing Assistance (42.8%)



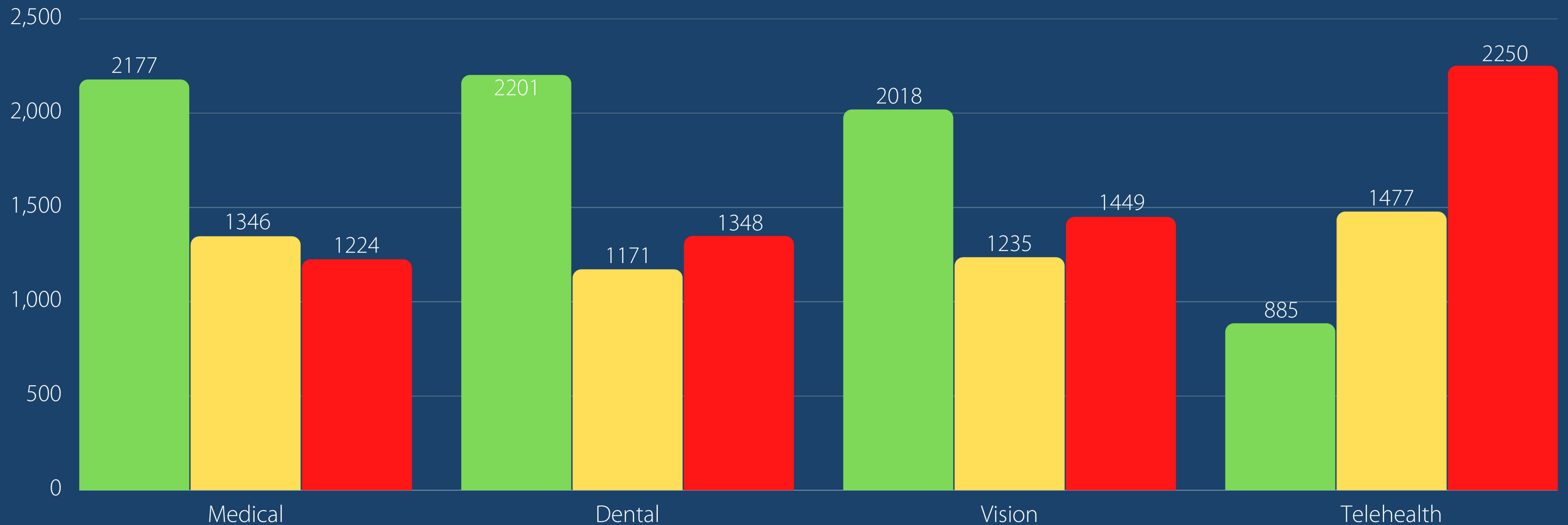

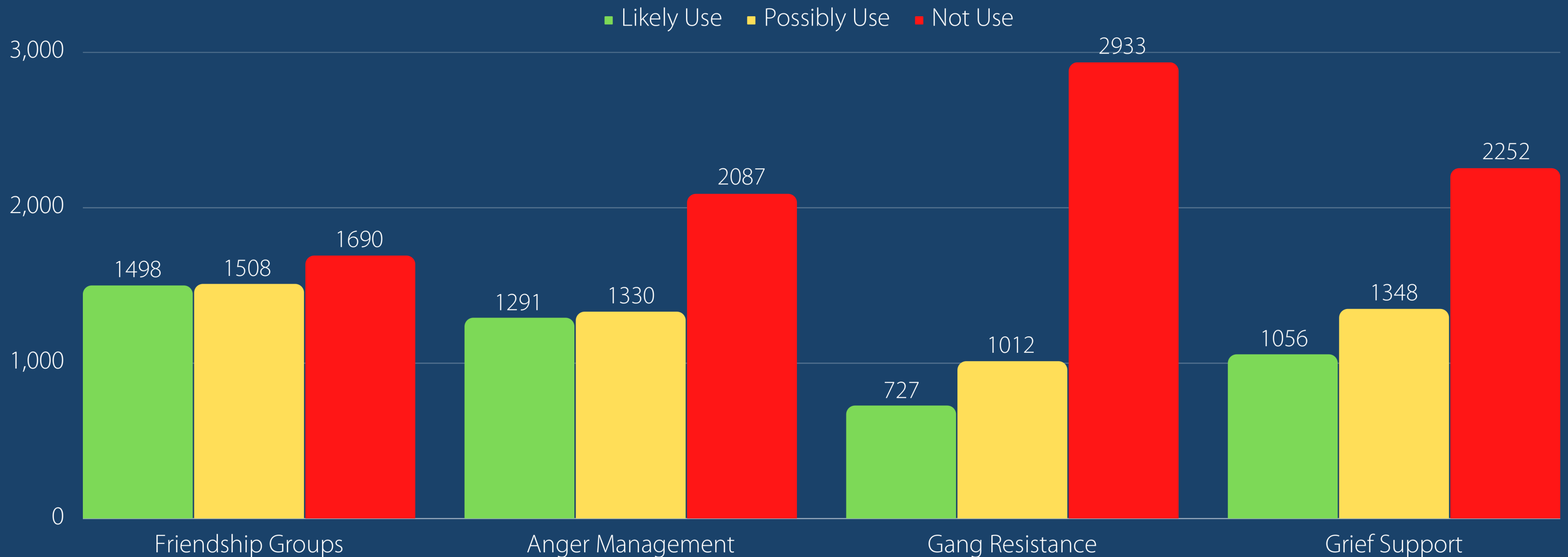

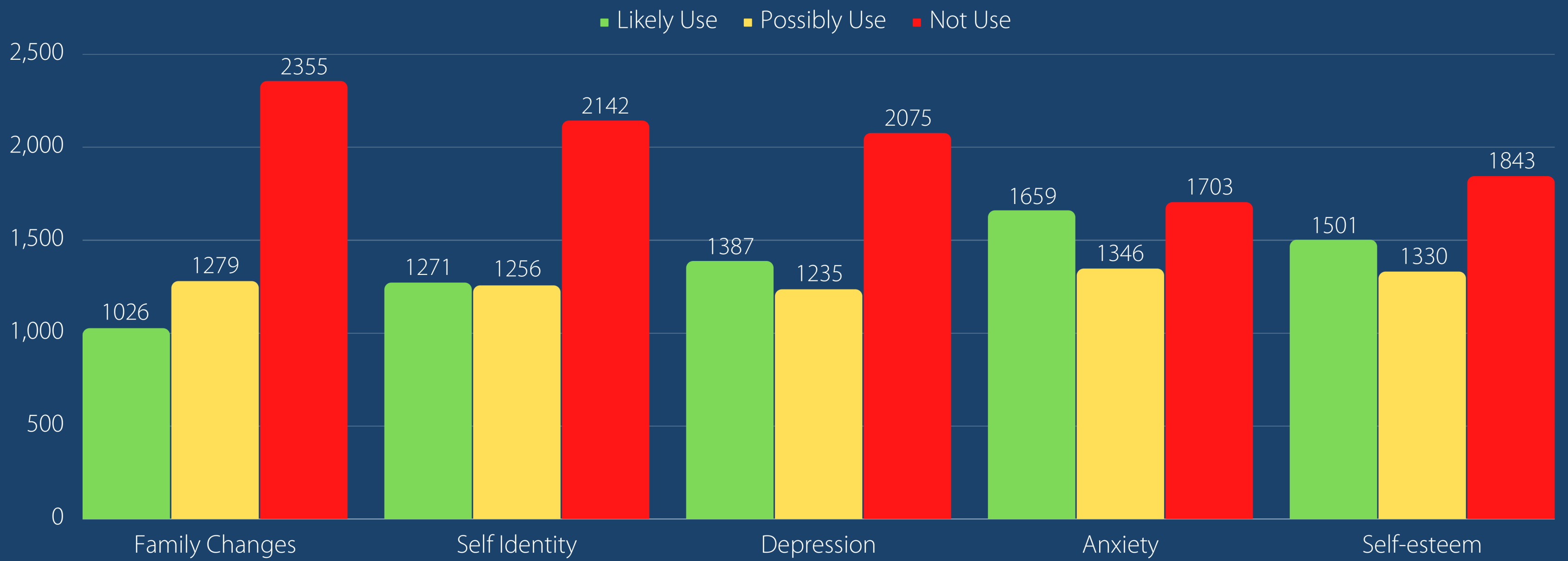

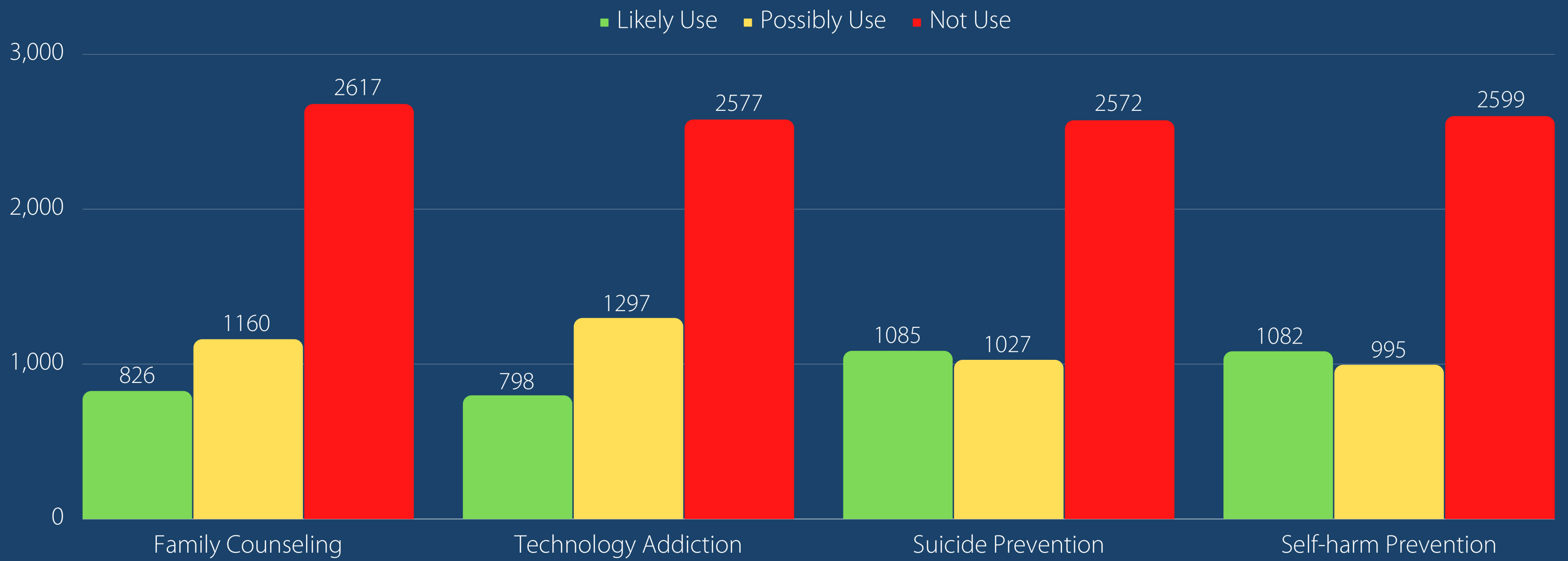

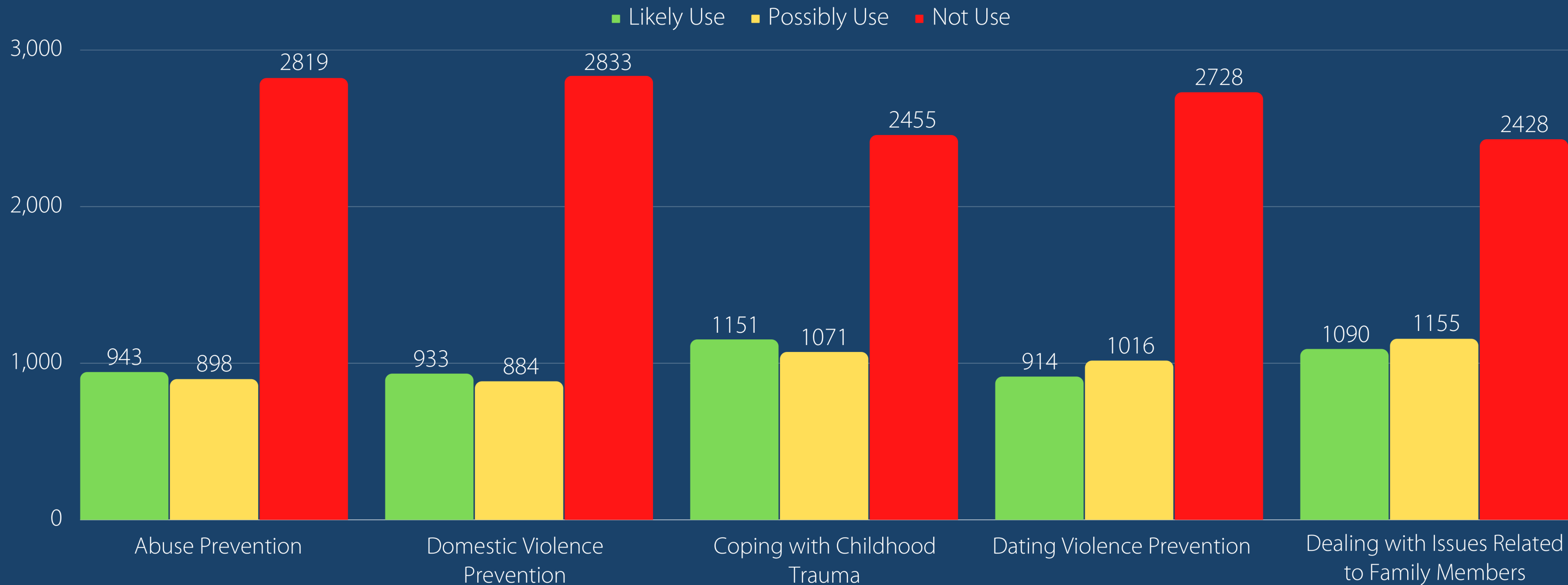

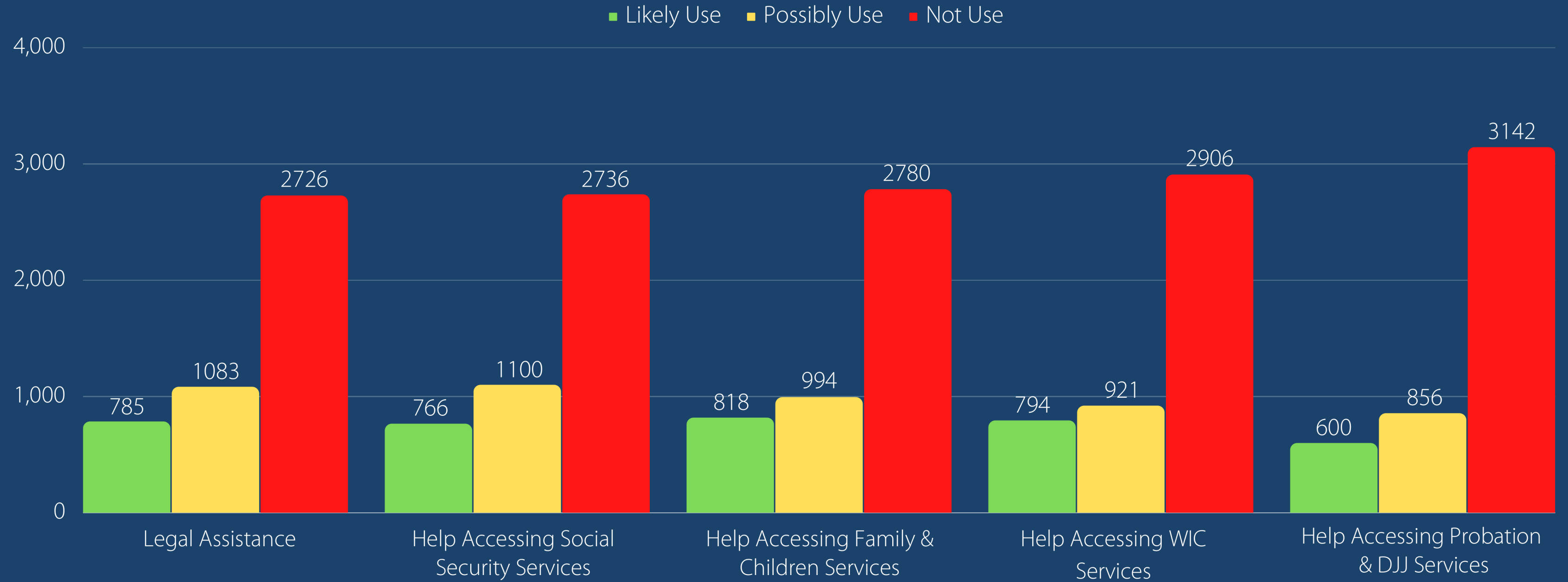

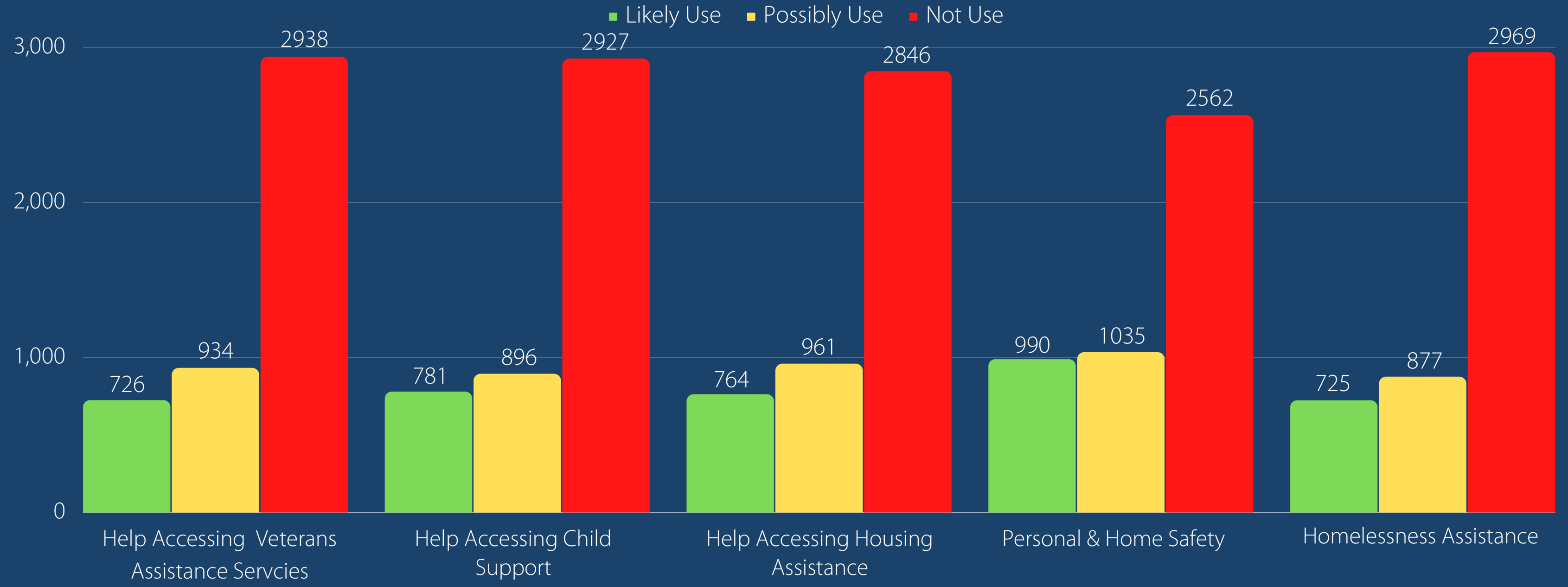

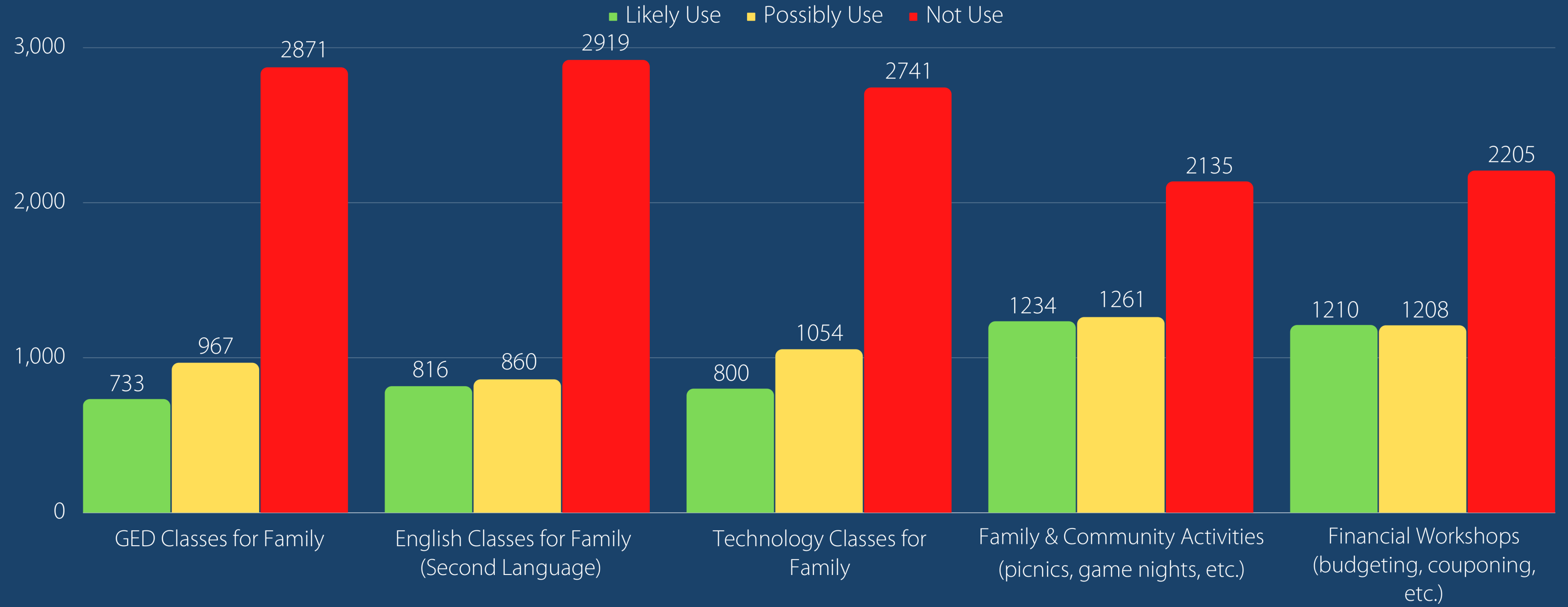

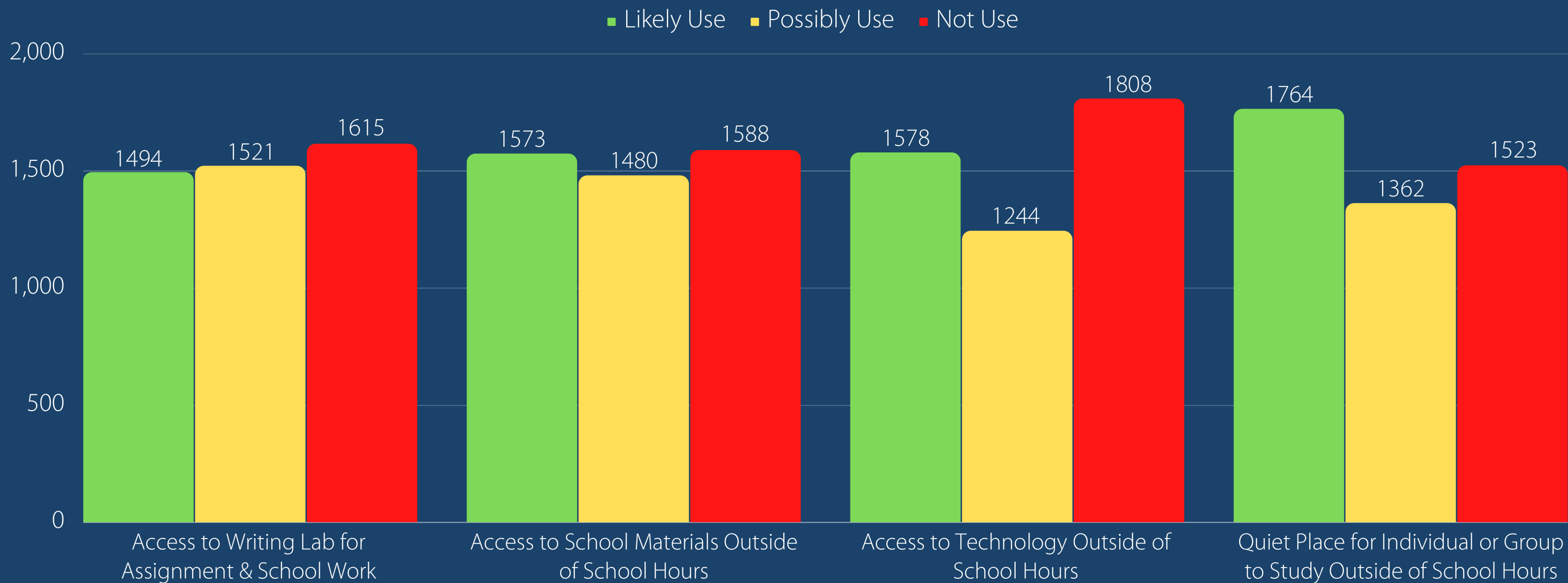

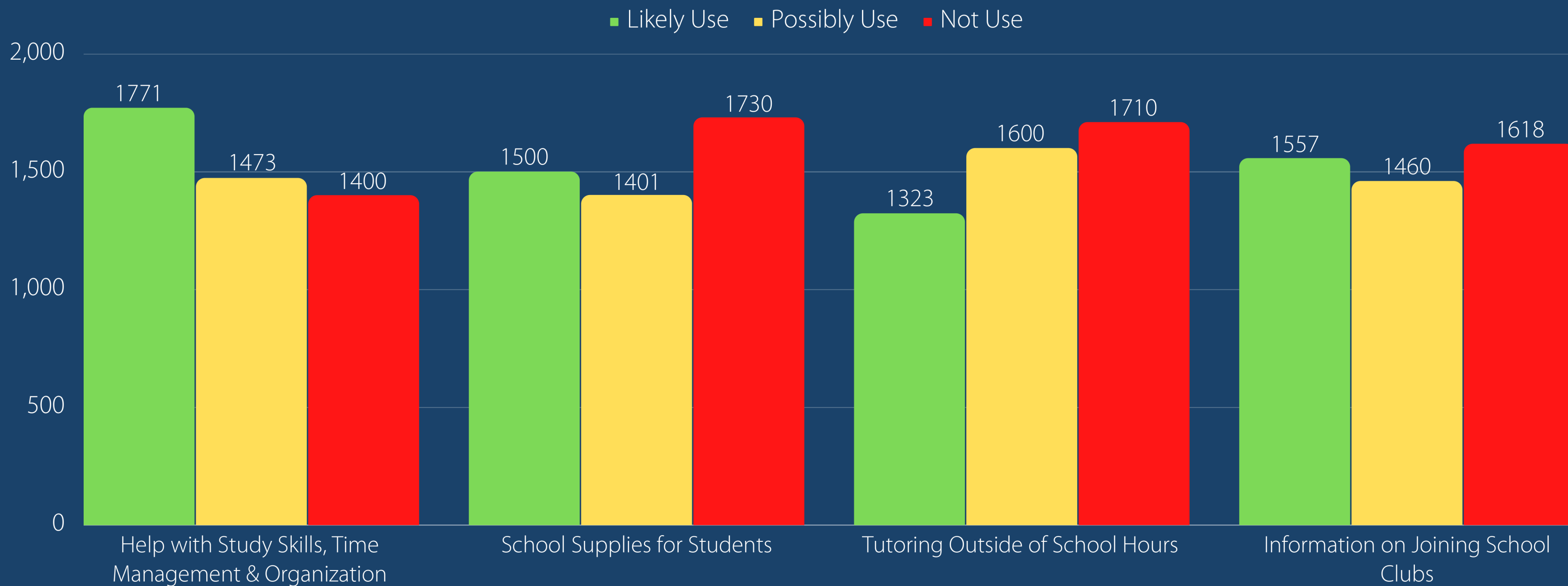

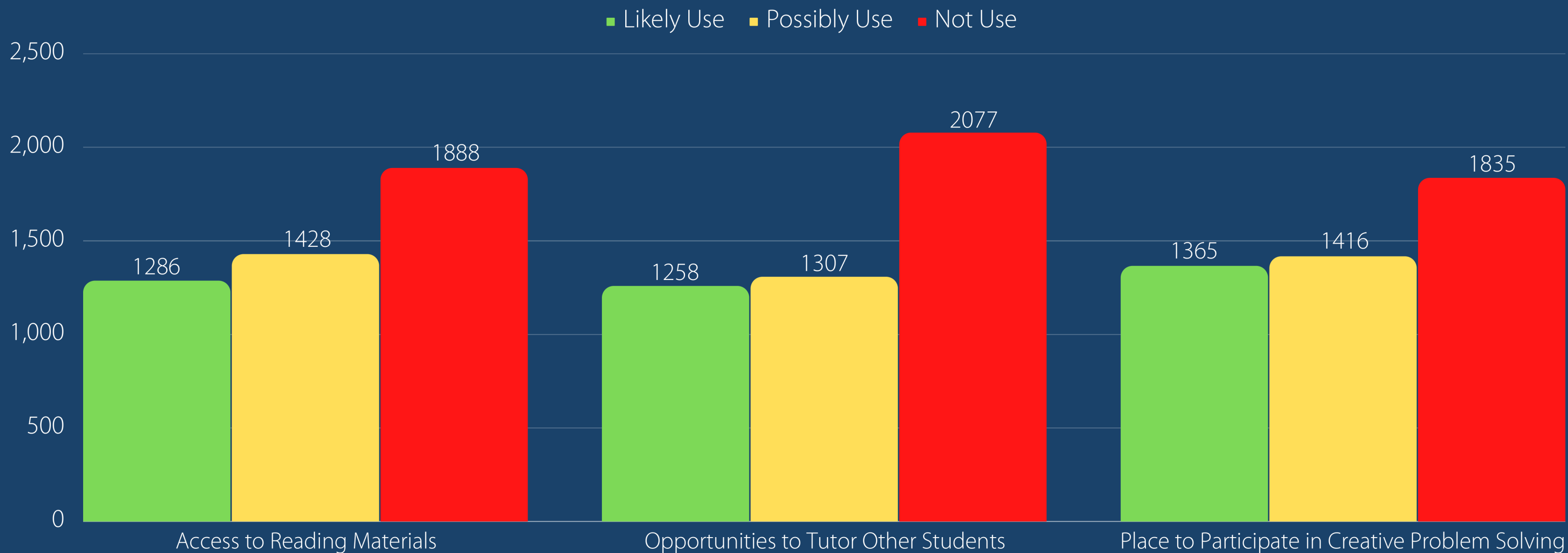

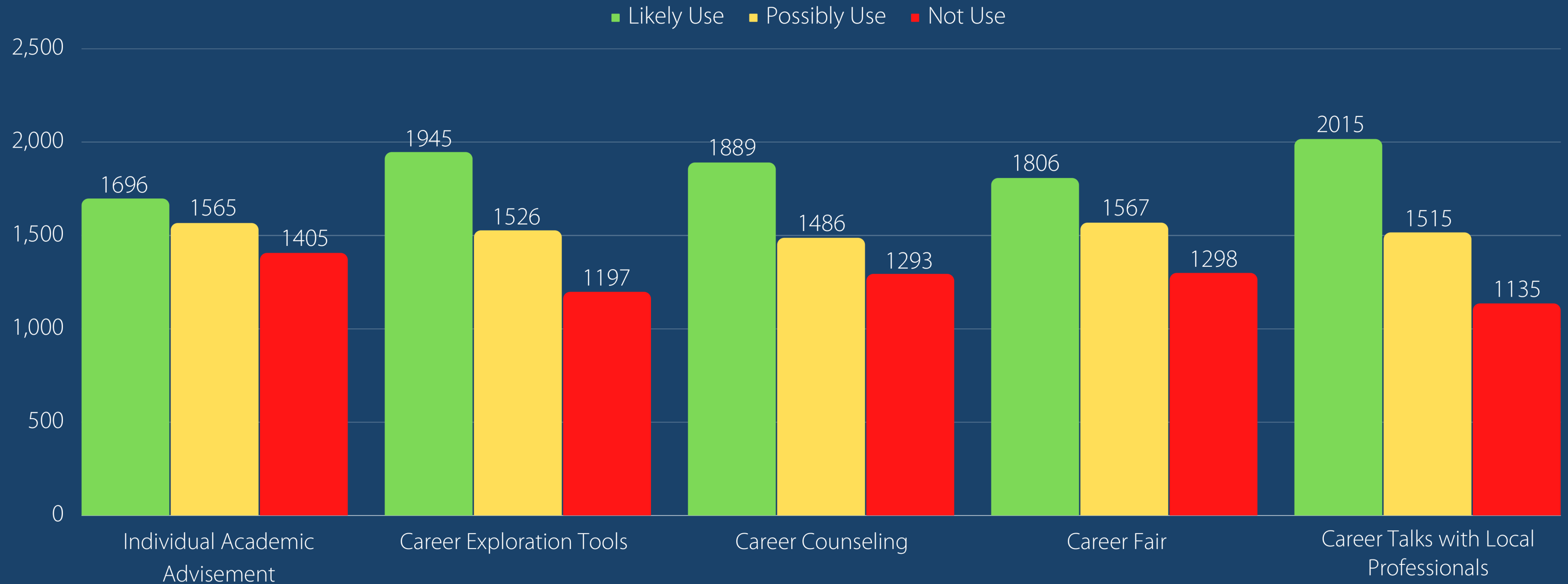

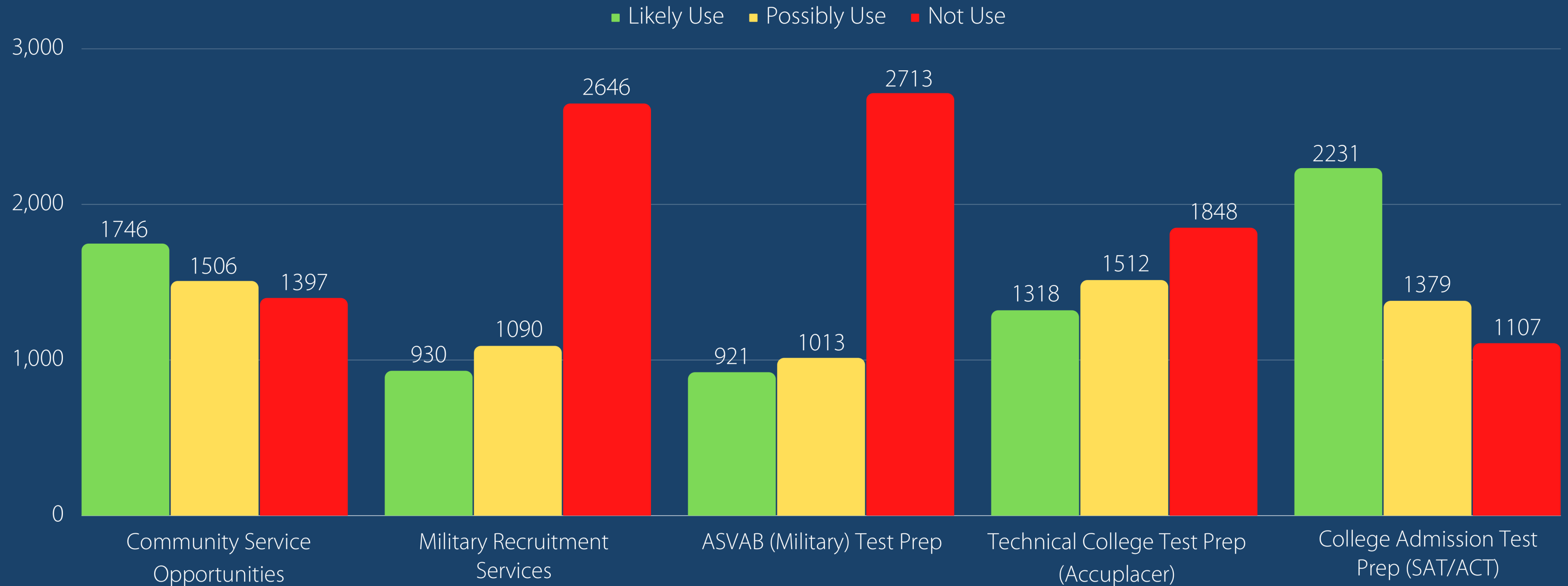
