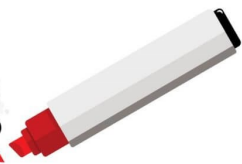


Thank you so much! We had a wonderful week of book sales. We were able to purchase over 70 books for the library with just the Sucker Pull money alone!

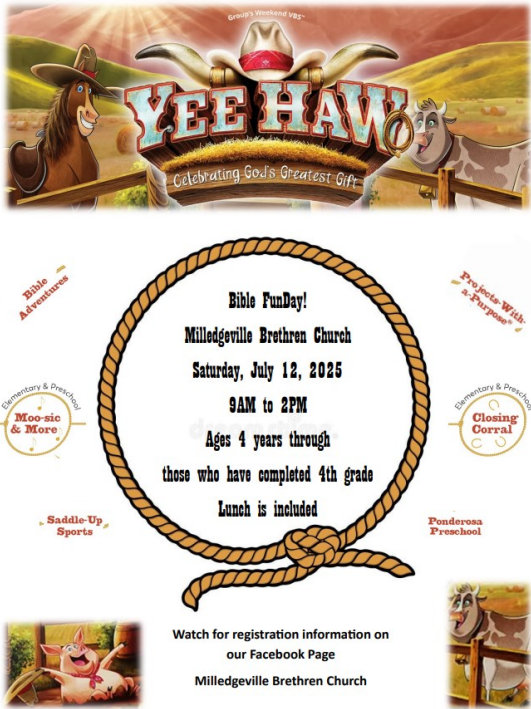
Kindergarten: School Physical, required immunizations, lead screening, dental exam, and vision exam
