

# **High School ACCESS Early College Program Morgantown, West Virginia - Main Campus**

## **Program Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be a current high school or homeschooled Sophomore, Junior, or Senior student.
- 3.0 or higher GPA

## **How to Apply:**

- All students must apply directly from the WVU High School ACCESS website during the posted application periods each semester: <a href="https://www.access.wvu.edu/apply">https://www.access.wvu.edu/apply</a>
  - Step 1: Complete the Online Application: Please follow the detailed instructions on the website. The digital application will go directly to WVU Admissions.
  - Step 2: Transcripts are Required: Upload your official or unofficial transcript to the MyWVU application portal as a part of the application process. This is a required step to be admitted.
  - Step 3: Complete the Enrollment Authorization Form: The form must have the GPA listed and the three required signatures. Please scan, email, or send as a picture attachment to the WVU HS ACCESS Director at <a href="mailto:accesswvu@mail.wvu.edu">accesswvu@mail.wvu.edu</a> You will have the opportunity to upload the enrollment form to your MyWVU application portal as well.

\*\*\* Please note that all accounts will remain pending without each of the required steps in place and confirmation from the WVU High School ACCESS Office. \*\*\*

### **Tuition Cost:**

- WV Resident Tuition Rate: \$25 per credit hour (3-credit hours course = \$75)
- **Non-Resident Tuition Rate:** \$75 per credit hour (3-credit hours course = \$225)
- No application fee to apply.
- Textbooks and other required supplies are NOT included in the tuition cost.

### **Available WVU Undergraduate Courses:**

- Students may take two <u>non-restricted</u> online, on-campus, and/or dual enrollment courses every Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters until your final term before graduation.
- Non-restricted **100-299** level courses are available under subjects ranging from A-W. Courses above 299-level will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- WVU's online and on-campus undergraduate courses are on a first come first served basis for <u>all</u> students.

(Please note: English: ENGL 101 and 102 courses are always <u>prohibited</u> for HS ACCESS students through the WVU Main Campus. Students will not be eligible to participate in HS ACCESS once they have officially graduated from high school.)

Please send official/digital ACT, SAT, or AP scores to the WVU Admissions Office to be attached to your WVU account. All scores must be in the WVU system prior to registration. WVU ALEKS Placement testing is available for admitted students each semester.
