  - ➤ AZMerit Update The 'new' letter grade system developed by the State Board of Education has strong a focus on student growth. We have already begun to look at areas for improvement and change in all of our schools; including:
    - Advanced Math at Jr. High and High School ensuring that students have access and are encouraged to take 8th grade Geometry and 12th grade B/C Calculus.
    - Tanque Verde Elementary Increase the focus of the Title 1 program on math intervention.
    - Emily Gray Junior High School Implement the use of "Newsela." This is an electronic instructional content platform that will provide students with ELA, Social Studies and Science curriculum that is aligned to the current standards and expectations.
    - Principals will work with teachers on ways to adjust schedules to support their instruction.
