During code yellow, doors remain locked, no one exits or enters, and cards are displayed to show status of the classroom. Instruction continues.

During code red, lights are off, windows covered, cards removed, instruction stops, students and teachers take cover.

Severe weather drill will take place this month in place of fire drill.
