
Attorney Schurin returned the hearing to public session at 10:17 a.m., at which time he took the following actions:

The hearing officer further moved on behalf of the Board that based upon such factual findings and legal conclusions the parties' Stipulated Expulsion Agreement be adopted in total as the Board's decision and that a letter be sent to both parties reiterating this decision.

Attorney Schurin adjourned the meeting at 10:18 a.m.
