STUDENT MEDICATIONS

FAFSA is a form students/families fill out to apply for financial aid for college or graduate school.

What is ORSAA?

ORSAA is an Oregon-developed application for students who are not eligible to complete the FAFSA. It is a confidential application that is used solely by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to qualify students for financial aid in Oregon.





The last day for the current meal route delivery will be effective Friday, February 12, 2021. The new delivery route program will start effective <u>Tuesday. USDA has granted a waiver to the Oregon Department of Education so the Seaside School District can provide a free grab-n-go meal service (breakfast/lunch) due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Meals are served at a designated site and children and/or an authorized adult may pick up meals for consumption off site. Only one arab-n-ao meal is allowable per child: however, an authorized adult may request additional meals for children that were unable to come to the delivery location.

Students who are attending On-Site



Pacific Ridge Elementary – Students who attend hybrid, in-person learning at the school will have the option of receiving a grab-n-go meal bag each day when they are released. Students will be required to notify school staff each day when they arrive that they would like to have a grab-n-go meal. Please be sure to remind your student because there will be no extra meals available if they do not let staff know when asked. Thanks!





Seaside Middle School / Seaside High School – Students who attend hybrid, in-person learning at the school will have the option of receiving a grab-n-go meal bag each day during a designated lunch period.

The School District's goal is to provide access to meals on all school days, including Wednesdays. We have had to modify our system to accommodate in-person learning, as well as, comprehensive distance learning and on-line thrive students. This meal program does still offer free access to all children 1-18!
