### CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT

Our main form of classroom management is Class Dojo. Class Dojo is an app that you can download on your phone. In this packet you will find all the information you need to set up an account for your child. I use Class Dojo to keep track of your child's behavior in class. There are positive points that you child can recieve and also a "needs to improve" point that they may lose for things they need to work on that may have happened at school. You will be notified for

all the points given or taken so that you can be in the know on how your student is doing. After earning a certain amount of points, they get little prizes to help motivate them to do their best!

# HOMEWORK POLICY

For homework this year, we will be doing a variety of worksheets. I do not believe in giving a huge homework load, but instead encouraging your child to play outside and have fun being a kid after being in school all day. However, some homework can be good for reviewing lessons learned in class. The primary homework will be a reading sheet with weekly skills and decodable stories to practice our phonics skills. I also add extra fluency and comprehension practice. These are not required, but they can help your child keep up with the pace of first grade. These count

towards our reading goal of 15 minutes a night. Your child should also be studying their spelling words for their weekly test.

\*Weekly Tests include Reading, Spelling, Grammar, and Math Skills. Scheduled tests will always be on the weekly homework sheet.

\*Graded Papers will come home weekly. I try to get them out on Fridays, but that is not always possible. I will send out a reminder when they are coming home.

### PARENT COMMUNICATION

As mentioned, the best way to contact me is through Parent Square messages or email. Please give me 24 hours to reply. If there is an afterschool pick-up change, it must be in writing, or you will need to contact the front office to communicate those changes. Again, please allow up to 24 hours to reply.

If you ever have any questions or concerns, I encourage you to please come straight to me. It would be more appreciated and helpful to hear from you, not a coworker or parent. Thank you so much!

You may send in store-bought treats for your child on their birthday. Our snack time is around 2:15.

#### Communication

You may message me on Parent Square. I will check it from 7:30-3:15 during the week. We have 24 hours to respond to messages. I will post weekly newsletters, reminders, and all other important information in Parent Square.

#### **Graded Papers**

Graded Papers are sent home weekly. I will get them to you on Fridays with the new homework packet. Please sign and return any papers that have a 69 or below.

#### Homework

The primary homework will be a reading sheet with weekly skills and decodable stories to practice our phonics skills. I also add extra fluency and comprehension practice. These are not required, but they can help your child keep up with the pace of first grade.

### Snack Time

We will have snack daily around 2:15. Your child may purchase snack in the mornings BEFORE they come to class: no glass water bottles and no sodas. Special Snack occurs once a month. This is a time when we allow the purchase of candy and sodas. Prices will be sent out via ClassDojo

#### Water Bottles
