Back to School Information

Please

- Keep students who are ill home
- Per Beecher 200U policy:
 - A temperature is considered 100 degrees or higher
 - Students must be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication before return to school
 - Students must be 24 hours vomiting and/or diarrhea free before returning to school
 - Illnesses more than three consecutive days (Non-Covid) require a doctor's note to return to school
- Keep positive cases home and notify the school nurse

Return to Normal

- Beecher 200U will open the school year:
 - Masking is up to the individual student and family
 - Positive COVID cases will quarantine for a minimum 5 days.
 - Students may return on day 6 if fever free and symptoms improve
 - There is NO remote learning for any non-quarantined students.
 - Classes and lunchrooms will return to capacity.

Vaccination Information

- District encourages individuals who are eligible to get the vaccine. The vaccine is NOT required.

Contact Tracing-No longer Required

- Since there is no longer a requirement to quarantine close contacts, tracing will only occur with a linked cluster of cases in the school setting.
- Families will continue to monitor their child's well-being and report positive cases to the school nurse.
