You have **five days** to make up the missed work. After five days, the missed assignments will **not** be accepted.

Late Work: You will receive half credit for up to five days after the due date for late assignments.

After five days, you will receive a **zero** for the missing work.

Text Replacement Cost: In this course, we will use the Houghton Mifflin Harcourt *Into Literature* 12th Grade textbook. If a student loses or damages a book, he/she will be responsible for paying a replacement fee.

Retest Policy: Students may retake **TWO** major assessments per semester within one week after the grade is returned. Students may not retest if they were found cheating or plagiarizing. Students may not retest if the task was never initially completed.

Plagiarism: If a student is caught plagiarizing, he/she will receive a zero as a placeholder, until the assignment is retaken. If the assignment is not made up, the zero will remain. In addition, your parent/guardian will be notified and you will receive administrative punishment.

Plagiarism is **NOT** tolerated at VHS.
