The April 28, 2022 special meeting was called for the purpose of conducting a student expulsion hearing. At the meeting, Attorney Schurin, serving as the hearing officer on behalf of the New Milford Board of Education, took the following actions.

Attorney Schurin called the hearing to order at 1:19 p.m. and at 1:21 p.m. moved the hearing into executive session as personally identifiable information relating to the student who was the subject of the hearing was likely to be discussed.


Attorney Schurin returned the hearing to public session at 1:32 p.m., at which time he took the following actions:

The hearing officer moved on behalf of the New Milford Board of Education that the Board approve the Stipulated Expulsion Agreement submitted by the parties in executive session and thereby expel the Student discussed in executive session for the term of one calendar year, as specified in the Stipulated Expulsion Agreement, and that the disciplinary consequences and other terms set forth in the Stipulated Expulsion Agreement be adopted.

The hearing officer further moved on behalf of the Board that the parties Stipulation be adopted in total as the Board's expulsion decision and that a letter be sent to both parties by the hearing officer reiterating this decision.

Attorney Schurin adjourned the meeting at 1:32 p.m.
