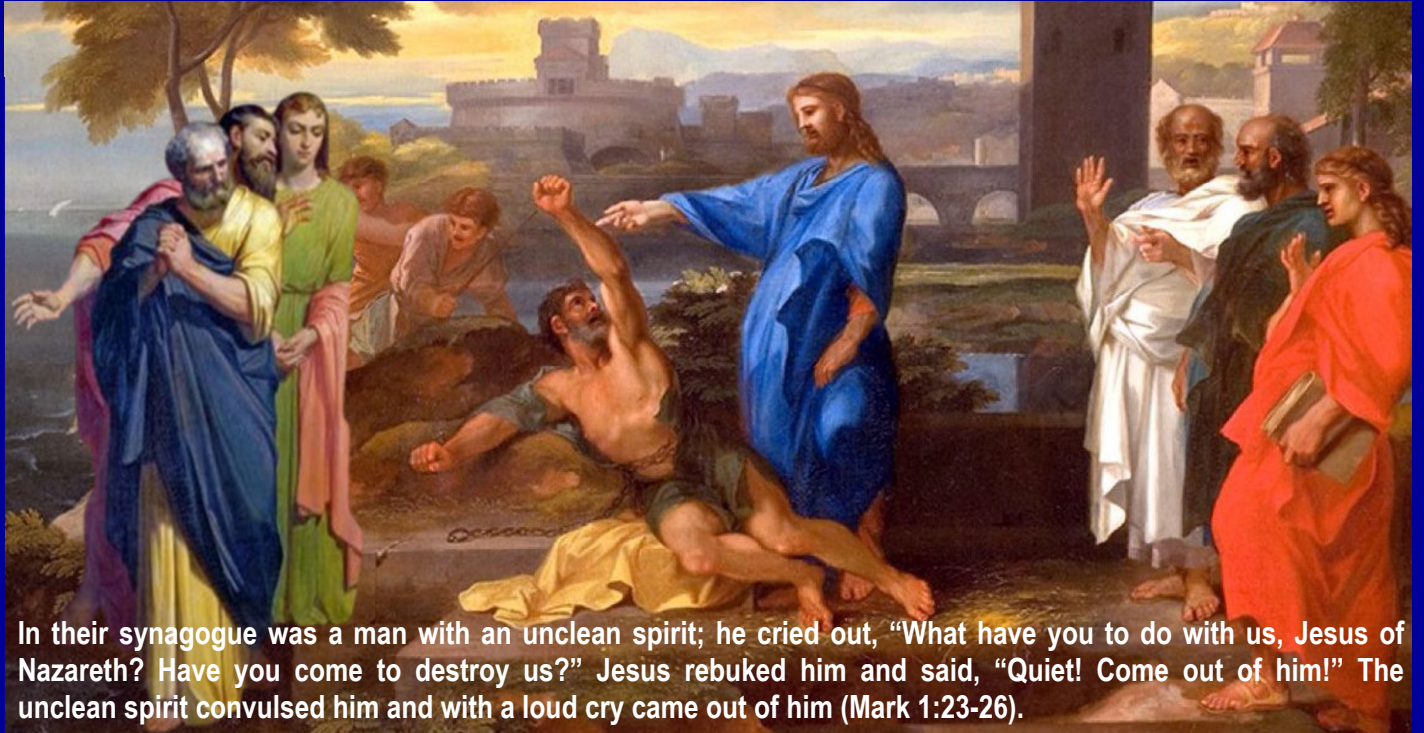

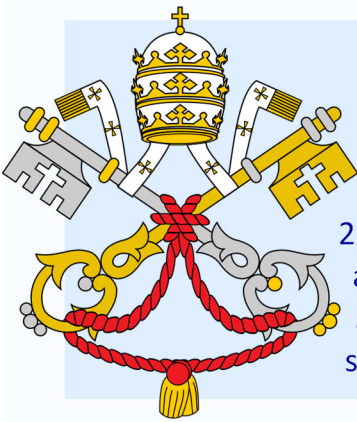

A Pastor's Response to *Fiducia Supplicans*:

My Dear Parishioners of St. Therese,

I want to address the recent document from The Holy See on the blessing of couples in irregular or same-sex relationships. Before proceeding, let it be said that it's good for all of us to read the actual document and then read good commentaries on the document so that we're not forming our opinions on false or misleading reporting. Doing so will also give us greater peace of mind and conviction to pray for our Church leaders. Below, I have provided a link to the Vatican document, along with three commentaries to aid you in this endeavor. They are all very thoughtful, fair, and critical—yet not mean-spirited.

The first commentary is from Archbishop Emeritus Charles Chaput, the former Ordinary of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. One especially insightful excerpt from his essay reads: *“The document is a doubleminded exercise in simultaneously affirming and undercutting Catholic teaching on the nature of blessings and their application to ‘irregular’ relationships. And it was quickly interpreted as a significant change in Church practice.”*

The second article makes an important distinction between doctrine and practice: *“The Vatican....has set out to appear to change the Church’s teaching without in fact changing it. The distinction is achieved by changing the practice but not the principle. Orthodoxy remains untarnished, but orthopraxy—correct practice and worship—has been subverted.”*

I encourage you to read these articles along with The Holy See document so that you can formulate for yourselves an educated opinion. My personal synthesis of what I’ve read on this topic leads me to conclude that no matter how much *Fiducia Supplicans* reaffirms the teaching of the Church on marriage and the inability to bless sin, the actual practice of giving blessings to couples in irregular or same-sex relationships by its very action sends the opposite message, thus leading to more confusion and pastoral abuse. In spite of this, I want to encourage each of us not to allow this poorly conceived and executed document to rattle our faith as it does not change the perennial teaching of the Church on the sanctity of marriage between one man and one woman. More than anything, it should impel us even more to pray for our leaders.

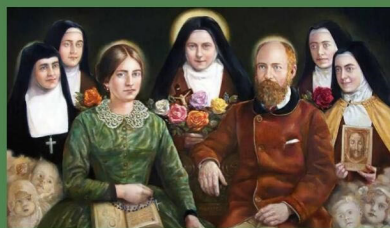

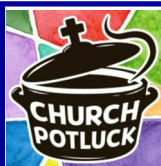

"LET ME INTRODUCE YOU..." By Fr. Stephen F. Watson, OCD

A Weekly Feature in the Bulletin for our Parish Centennial



As we made ourselves comfortable in her living room, Elayne said with obvious contentment, "I am sure grateful to have lived in this house for these past sixty-years." In fact, Elayne has lived in the same house on Alhambra Road for more than sixty years, ever since her late husband, Larry Hoh, carried her across the threshold after their wedding in 1960. Larry and Elayne Hoh (the name is German) added three more Hohs, as in Michael Hoh, Stephen Hoh, and Peter Hoh. (I know what you're thinking, "Hoh, Hoh, Hoh".)

At age 32, Larry Hoh, a structural engineer, came to Alhambra to work for CF Braun Company, which had a factory in Alhambra. Located at the corner of Fremont Avenue and Mission Road, it was one of the most formidable petrochemical engineering companies in the world during the post-World War II period. During the 1950's, CF Braun employed over six thousand employees.

At about the time Larry arrived in Alhambra, Elayne Langenieux was graduating in the first class of San Diego College for Women. (This college was founded by the Society of the Sacred Heart and merged with San Diego University in 1972.) When Elayne was six, the Langenieuxs came to California for the good of her health. Elayne's older sister had died of an illness and the parents were devastated. Elayne grew up in Altadena and attended St. Elizabeth's Parish School. She then graduated from Mayfield High School. She met Larry in 1959 at St. Philip Parish's Young Adults group. They were married the following year. (Elayne likes to say that her mother went from being Miss Lee to Mrs. Langenieux and she went from Miss Langenieux to Mrs. Hoh.) Elayne's great uncle, Cardinal Benoît-Marie Langenieux, Bishop of Tarbes, consecrated the Rosary Chapel at Lourdes and was active in the canonization of St. Joan of Arc.

Elayne had no siblings or cousins and had not been around children that much. Suddenly, she had her hands full with three boys—born in 1961, 1962, and 1964. Learning to be a mom was on-the-job training. The boys attended St. Therese Parish School, which made for an easy walk to school. Elayne took her turn as lunch chairperson, room mother, and parish council president. For many years every Monday, Elayne, along with Peggy Centola, Lois Johnson, and Ronnie Ellis, counted the Sunday collection. She also helped Bridie McDermott with the Christian Services program, which provided baskets for the needy at Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. In addition to that, Elayne was also on hand to help out with the lunch-receptions that Christian Services organized and hosted after our funeral Masses. Later, Kay Tunney got her to join the Discalced Carmelite Nuns' Auxiliary, of which she was the president for many years. It had a quilting circle that met every week at Mary Cassidy's house. The beautiful quilt was then auctioned at the annual Spring *Shower of Roses* for the financial benefit of the Carmelite Nuns. Mary Jane Craig, Delores McAllister, and Celia Makiewicz were also part of the circle.

Elayne has been a widow since March 13, 2000. She misses her beloved very much. Although Elayne took the lead when it came to parish activities, Larry was always there as her "Guy Friday." Elayne has always been surrounded by good men: three sons, four grandsons, and two great grandsons. Elayne Hoh's 64-year history at St. Therese Parish is like a beautiful stained glass window reflecting the divine rays that have showered the Parish for the past 99 years.

Three Appearances by Our Lady to Lucia—June 1929 ~ Our Lady Requests Consecration of Russia:

Over the years at the convent, Our Lady appeared many times to Sr. Lucia. In 1929, she appeared to her and repeated her request for the consecration of Russia to Her Immaculate Heart, as she had requested during her Third Apparition on July 13, 1917. Sr. Lucia made this request known to her confessor, who asked her to write it down and present a letter to the Bishop. The Bishop brought the request to the attention of the Holy Father. Years later, when WWII was expanding in 1942, Pope Pius XII consecrated "the world and Russia" to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This was not exactly as Our Lady had requested it, so in 1984 Pope John Paul II consecrated "the world including Russia" to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

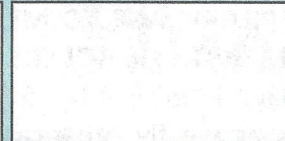

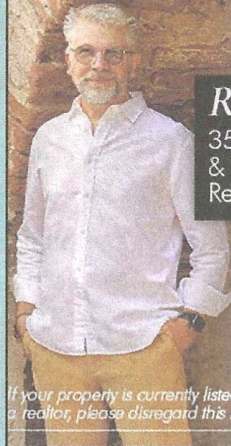
